### Roads Temporarily Closed

ROAD SECTION	COMMENTS
Birdsville Inside Track	Due to flooding.
Cooper Creek Ferry Crossing Road	Due to flood damage until further notice.
Merty Merty - Cameron Corner	Due to extensive damage to road.
Mt Barry to San Marino	Due to ponded water over road, very soft sections and deep wheel rutting.
Mungeranie - Kalamurina	Road impassable due to extensive road damage and water over the road.

### 4WD Only (under 3 tonne / no towing)

ROAD SECTION	COMMENTS
Arrabury Road	Caution at soft sections, wheel rutting and corrugation. Drive to conditions.
Cordillo Downs Road - Arrabury turn off to SA/QLD Border	Caution at soft sections, wheel rutting and corrugation. Drive to conditions.
Cordillo Downs Road - Innamincka to Arrabury turn off	Caution at soft sections, wheel rutting and corrugation. Drive to conditions.
Farina to Mulgaria via Witchelina	Suitable for high clearance vehicles only.

### 4WD/HV Only

ROAD SECTION	COMMENTS
Birdsville Track - Mungeranie to Marree	Extreme caution at flagged hazards, gutters, scours, at wheel rutting and at creek crossings. Pondered water is trafficable due to hard road base. Do not detour around water as edges very soft.
Birdsville Track - SA Border to Mungeranie	Extreme caution at flagged hazards, severe gutters, scours, at wheel rutting and at sand bars in creek crossings and low areas. Pondered water is trafficable due to hard road base. Do not detour around water as edges very soft. Daylight travel only.
Hideaway to Curnamona via Martins Well	Caution at creek crossings, bulldust holes and ponded water.
Moralana Scenic Drive	Caution at creek crossings, scours & corrugations.
Mt Hopeless - Balcanoona (via Moolawatana)	Caution at wheel rutting and ponded water sections.

## Roads Open with Warnings

ROAD SECTION	COMMENTS
<b>Brachina Gorge Road</b>	Suitable for high clearance vehicles only due to rocky creek sections. Drive to conditions.
<b>Bunyeroo Gorge Road</b>	Caution at stony section through Bunyeroo Creek (approx. 50m)
<b>Coober Pedy - William Creek</b>	Caution wheel rutting, bulldust holes and corrugations.
<b>Hamilton - Oodnadatta</b>	Caution at bulldust section approx. 20km north of Oodnadatta turn off. Drive to conditions
<b>Innamincka - Nappa Merrie</b>	Caution at sections where seal has been damaged.
<b>Iron Knob to Hiltaba</b>	Caution at creek crossings & scours in Nonning to Siam station areas.
<b>Lyndhurst - Marree</b>	Caution due to damaged seal. Be aware of speed restrictions at various locations.
<b>Marree - Muloorina</b>	Caution at road scours and gutters. Drive to conditions.
<b>Mintabie Road</b>	Caution at wheel rutting and road scours.
<b>Mt Barry to Arkaringa</b>	Caution at corrugations. Drive to conditions.
<b>Mt Dare - Hamilton</b>	Caution at soft sections and creek crossings. Drive to conditions.
<b>Oodnadatta Track - Marla to Oodnadatta</b>	Caution at scours and wash outs first 20km north of Oodnadatta, soft sections and roadworks approximately 80kms from Marla. Speed restrictions are in place, follow direction from road crews when driving through the site.
<b>Oodnadatta Track - Oodnadatta to William Creek</b>	Caution at creek crossings, road scours and ponded water areas.
<b>Oodnadatta Track - William Creek to Marree</b>	Caution at creek crossings and wheel rutted sections. Caution at heavy corrugations in the Coward Springs area.
<b>Painted Desert Road</b>	Caution at corrugations. Drive to conditions.
<b>Rawnsley Park - Martins Well</b>	Caution at signed hazard - bulldust hole.
<b>Roxby Downs to Bopeechee (Borefield Road)</b>	Caution at corrugated sections and ponded water drive to conditions
<b>Strzelecki Track - Innamincka to Merty Merty</b>	Caution heavy corrugations and bulldust sections from Art Baker to Innamincka.
<b>Strzelecki Track - Merty Merty to Mt Hopeless</b>	Caution heavy corrugations and bulldust sections from Art Baker to Innamincka.
<b>Strzelecki Track - Mt Hopeless to Lyndhurst</b>	Caution heavy corrugations and bulldust sections from Art Baker to Innamincka.
<b>Tarcoola - Glendambo</b>	Caution at bulldust holes and soft sections.
<b>Tea Tree - Yunta</b>	Caution at wheel rutted sections and creek crossings. Drive to Conditions. Caution also at roadworks from Yunta for 10km. Speed restrictions are in place; follow direction from road crews when driving through the site.
<b>The Knob - Mt Fitton Mine</b>	Caution at creek crossings.
<b>Thurlga Station to Kimba</b>	Caution at washouts and wheel ruts.
<b>Yardea Station to Minnipa</b>	Caution at corrugated sections.

### SPECIAL EVENTS AND NOTICES

#### Public Access Routes

Public Access Routes (PARs) are established under the Pastoral Land Management and Conservation Act 1989 (PLMC Act) to provide public access over pastoral land without the need for travellers to ask permission from the lessee. Any travel other than that on a public road or PAR requires prior approval from the lessee of the respective pastoral lease.

Pursuant to section 45 (7) of the PLMC Act, the Pastoral Board may temporarily close a PAR for the purposes of the safety of the public, the management of stock or the carrying out of rehabilitative work on the land adjacent to the route.

PARs are not roads or part of the formal road network. They are unimproved and unsurfaced dirt tracks intended to provide four-wheel drive access in dry conditions only. Conditions such as washouts and corrugations may be present. Drive to track conditions with caution. All PARs are currently OPEN unless listed below.
