Evidence of Identity

When you apply for a learner's permit, you will be asked to provide evidence of your identity.

You will have to provide at least 3 documents, including:

- one item from Category A and two items from Category B, OR
- two items from Category A and one item from Category B
- evidence of change of name if you've changed your name, or your name is different on the documents presented.

The three documents presented must together provide your full name, signature, date of birth and current residential address.

If the documents you provide don't show your current residential address you must provide a fourth document. This should be a document from the list of documents on the Evidence of address for registration and licensing purposes table shown on page 2.

If you have to provide evidence of change of name, this should be two documents from the *Evidence of change of name* table on page 2.

If you are genuinely unable to present the evidence required, you may need to complete an *Evidence of Identity Verification Form* - phone 13 10 84 for more information.

NOTE: The list of items shown in *Category A* is not complete.

Documents not likely to be relevant to Aboriginal people have been removed. To see the full list, go to pages 102 and 103 of *The Driver's Handbook*.

Category A

- An Australian birth certificate. (A commemorative certificate, certified copy or extract is not acceptable.)
- A current Australian passport or one that has expired within the last two years.
- A photograph and/or signature stored on the Registrar of Motor Vehicles' photographic licence database.
- A South Australian or Federal Police Officer photo identity card.
- A South Australian proof of age card issued after 9 October 2006.
- An Australian photo driver's licence or learner's permit that is current or has expired within the last two years.
- An 'Extract from Register of Citizenship by Descent' issued by an Australian embassy where the parent(s) are Australian-born.

Category B

- A proof of age or photo ID card issued by an interstate government authority.
- A current Medicare card, Pensioner Concession Card, Department of Veterans' Affairs entitlement card or any other current entitlement card issued by the Australian Government.
- · A telephone, gas or electricity bill up to six months old.
- A water rates, council rates or land valuation notice up to twelve months old.
- An Australian Defence Force photo identity card (excluding civilian staff and family).
- An electoral enrolment card or other evidence of enrolment up to two years old.
- A student identity document from an Australian educational institution, with photograph and/or signature, that is current or expired up to twelve months.
- An Australian-issued security guard or crowd controller licence showing photograph.
- An Occupational licence (Consumer and Business Services) showing photograph.
- · An armed services discharge document up to twelve months old.
- An Australian issued firearms licence showing photograph.
- A current credit or debit card that shows the embossed or printed name and signature, or account card from a bank, building society or credit union, or a passbook up to one year old.
- A completed MR1418 Confirmation of residential address and signature to enrol a client with the Registrar of Motor Vehicles 68.2 KB form (available from a Service SA Customer Service Centre) or a letter up to one year old from a bank, building society or credit union that shows your full name and demonstrates your signature has been verified by the bank, building society or credit union.

Evidence of Identity (Page 2)

Evidence of address for registration and licensing purposes

You need to supply only one of these documents if your residential address is not included on a Category A or Category B document:

- · current South Australian vehicle registration certificate
- South Australian driver's licence or vehicle registration renewal for the coming period
- · contract of sale, lease arrangement or rental receipt for your place of residence up to two years old
- last or current financial year Australian Taxation Office tax assessment (please black out your Tax File Number)
- certificate or statement of enrolment from an educational institution that is up to one year old
- letter (up to one year old) signed by the principal/deputy principal/head of school of a recognised educational
 institution, or a person with authority to sign on their behalf, on the institution's letterhead which verifies your
 address
- completed MR1418 Confirmation of residential address and signature to enrol a client with the Registrar of Motor Vehicles 68.2 KB form (available from a Service SA Customer Service Centre)
- letter (up to one year old) from a bank, building society or credit union that shows your full name and demonstrates your residential address has been verified by the bank, building society or credit union (statements and screenshots from financial institutions are not acceptable with, or without, financial institution branch stamps).


Evidence of Change of Name

The following documents must be presented to record a change of name:

• full evidence of identity in the current or former name (or an Australian driver's licence or a South Australian proof of age card issued after 9 October 2006)

AND one of the following:

- birth certificate with an endorsement from an Australian registrar of births, deaths and marriages (BDM)
- marriage certificate issued by an Australian BDM (commemorative certificates issued by a religious leader or celebrant are not acceptable)
- foreign marriage certificate that has an apostille stamp or is accompanied by an apostille certificate (apostille stamps and certificates are issued by a government of or in a country which authenticates the signature and or seal of a public official on a public document issued by that country and is intended for use in a foreign country) with an English translation if applicable
- change of name certificate issued by an Australian BDM registrar
- deed poll certificate (previously issued by Lands Title Registration Office)
- divorce papers Decree Nisi or Absolute (indicating the name being reverted to).
