APPLICATION UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1991

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act), dated 1 November 2023.

Your application seeks access to:

"1) The Minister's official diary in weekly view (eg. 'outlook' weekly view) from 1 April 2023 to the current date. 2) Any itineraries for the minister's visits to the Eyre Peninsula in 2023 that relate to infrastructure / transport / utilities development and any briefing / talking points associated with any meetings / site inspections in respect of 1)."

An extensive search was conducted within this office. A total of 9 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application.

I grant you access in part to 2 documents; copies of which are enclosed. I refuse you access in full to 7 documents.

Documents Released in Part

The Minister's official diary is released in part from the date range 10 July 2023 to 1 November 2023, as his diary has been released under previous FOI determinations and therefore are already publicly available on the Department for Infrastructure and Department website (23MIT7766 and 23MIT8680).

Document 1 is released in part with out of scope information, not relating to the subject of your application redacted.

Calendar entries relating to the Minister's functions as a Member of Parliament do not fall within the scope of your request, as a Member of Parliament is not an "agency" within the meaning of the FOI Act. These entries have been redacted as out of scope.

Mobile numbers of public servants have been redacted pursuant to clause 6 to the FOI Act.

Personal appointments and meetings which took place at the Minister's electorate office have been redacted as this is non-work related and are the personal affairs of the Minister.

Details of Cabinet and Cabinet Committee meetings have been redacted.

Document 8 is an event brief prepared by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) for the Minister's attendance at the National Bush Summit. The document contains information between the City of Port Lincoln (the Council) and government and should be exempt pursuant to clause 5(1)(a)(i) and (ii) of the FOI act, as it is a document or contains information between local government and the government, and if disclosed would divulge information from a confidential intergovernmental communication. This may affect future communication between the Council and the government. While there is a strong public interest in government accountability and transparency, there is also the competing public interest to ensure that full and frank communications between varying jurisdictions can occur in confidence.

In addition, attachment 2 to Document 8 are already publicly available and therefore has not been provided to you. Attachment 3 is a copy of Document 2 and should be exempt pursuant to clause 5.

Documents Refused in Full

Document 2 is a letter from the Mayor and Chief Executive Officer of the City of Port Lincoln in relation to funding to the Port Lincoln Foreshore Project.

Document 6 is a meeting brief prepared by the Department for the Minister's meeting with the Mayor and Chief Executive Officer of the City of Port Lincoln in relation to the Port Lincoln town jetty.

Document 9 is a briefing paper provided to the Minister from the City of Port Lincoln ahead of the Minister's visit to Port Lincoln to discuss the town jetty renewal works.

Documents 2, 6 and 9 are exempt, pursuant to clause 5(1)(a)(i) and (ii) of the FOI act, as it is a document or contains information between local government and the government, and if disclosed would divulge information from a confidential intergovernmental communication. This may affect future communication between the Council and the government. While there is a strong public interest in government accountability and transparency, there is also the competing public interest to ensure that full and frank communications between varying jurisdictions can occur in confidence.

Document 3 is an event brief prepared by the Department for Energy and Mining (DEM) in relation to the National Bush Summit. Information contained in the briefing

is publicly available and therefore has not been provided to you. I have provided the link to the Summit for your information - <u>Bush Summit (splashthat.com)</u>.

Document 4 is an event brief prepared by DEM in relation to the Minister's attendance at the 19th Global Maintenance Upper Spencer Gulf Conference and Trade Expo 2023.

Document 5 are speaking notes prepared for the Minister to speak at the Conference and Trade Expo. Information contained in Documents 4 and 5 are publicly available and therefore has not been provided to you. I have provided the link to the Expo for your information - <u>TACTIC-Presentations - Tactic</u>.

Document 7 is a meeting brief prepared by DEM in relation to the Minister's visit to Nyrstar. The document contains a deliberation of Cabinet which I determine should be exempt pursuant to clause 1(1)(e). This is also an internal working document which contains information and opinion prepared for the deliberation and consideration by the Minister and is relevant to the decision-making functions of the Minister concerning the approval of the Department's Critical Minerals Strategy. The Critical Minerals Strategy has not yet been finalised and the details are not in the public domain. This is sensitive and confidential information.

It is not in the public interest to disclose the contents of this document as it is important for the government to receive frank and comprehensive advice and opinions. Whilst there is a strong public interest in government accountability and transparency, there is the competing public interest to ensure that full and frank advice can occur in confidence. I therefore determine this information exempt pursuant to clause 9.

Information relating to the business and commercial affairs of Nyrstar are contained within Document 7 and disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to have an adverse effect on those affairs by reducing their commercial advantage in a competitive field. I therefore determine this information exempt pursuant to clause 7(1)(c).

Exemptions

Clause 1 – Cabinet documents

- (1) A document is an exempt document-
 - (a) if it is a document that has been specifically prepared for submission to Cabinet (whether or not it has been so submitted); or
 - (b) if it is a preliminary draft of a document referred to in paragraph (a); or
 - (c) if it is a document that is a copy of or part of, or contains an extract from, a document referred to in paragraph (a) or (b); or
 - (e) if it contains matter the disclosure of which would disclose information concerning any deliberation or decision of Cabinet;

Clause 5 - Documents affecting inter-governmental or local governmental relations

- (1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter-
 - (a) the disclosure of which-
 - (i) could reasonably be expected to cause damage to intergovernmental relations; or
 - (ii) would divulge information from a confidential intergovernmental communication; and
 - (b) the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

Clause 6 – Documents affecting personal affairs

(1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead).

Clause 7– Documents affecting business affairs

- (1) A document is an exempt document—
 - (a) if it contains matter the disclosure of which would disclose trade secrets of any agency or any other person; or
 - (b) if it contains matter-

.

- (i) consisting of information (other than trade secrets) that has a commercial value to any agency or any other person; and
- (ii) the disclosure of which-
 - (A) could reasonably be expected to destroy or diminish the commercial value of the information; and
 - (B) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest; or
- (c) if it contains matter-
 - (i) consisting of information (other than trade secrets or information referred to in <u>paragraph (b)</u>) concerning the business, professional, commercial or financial affairs of any agency or any other person; and
 - (ii) the disclosure of which-
 - (A) could reasonably be expected to have an adverse effect on those affairs or to prejudice the future supply of such information to the Government or to an agency; and
 - (B) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

Clause 9 — Internal working documents

- (1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter-
 - (a) that relates to-
 - (i) any opinion, advice or recommendation that has been obtained, prepared or recorded; or
 - (ii) any consultation or deliberation that has taken place,

in the course of, or for the purpose of, the decision-making functions of the Government, a Minister or an agency; and

(b) the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

PURPOSE

• The purpose of the Bush Summit event is to create a stronger nation by standing up for regional Australians and giving a voice to their communities.

BACKGROUND

- The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) together with the Department of Primary Industries and Regions, South Australia (PIRSA) is embarking on a partnership with NewsCorp to support the first South Australian Bush Summit in Port Lincoln on 15 August 2023.
- The Bush Summit will celebrate and showcase regional South Australia, address the challenges facing rural communities and identify solutions.
- Politicians, leaders and policy makers will be joined by regional leaders across a range of industries including agriculture, resources, small business, health, education, technology and employment.
- The Department for Infrastructure and Transport and PIRSA's partnership will include advertising, editorial and event inclusions. Through the partnership a series of positive regional new stories will be identified in collaboration with NewsCorp.

KEY SPEAKING POINTS

- The State Government budget in June 2023 announced:
 - More than \$350 million over the forward estimates for regional road maintenance by the Department as part of its annual road maintenance program.
 - \$20 million over four years to address critical works across the state's jetties, by providing assistance to regional councils struggling to maintain these crucial community assets.

- \$23.5 million over four years to ensure the continuation of bus services in regional South Australia.
- \$15.8 million over four years for regional school bus services to replace the existing bus fleet with four-wheel-drive buses on Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara (APY) Lands, and to replace existing large buses in the regions.
- \$10 million over four years for regional road safety infrastructure upgrades, including audio-tactile line-marking, safety barriers, and rural junction activated warning systems at regional intersections.
- \$6.2 million over four years (\$1.5 million per annum indexed) for additional Kangaroo Island road improvements and maintenance. This is in addition to the \$2 million per annum already provided to Kangaroo Island Council.
- \$3 million over four years to support the Outback Communities Authority in delivering improved public facilities and community services in outback townships. This is in addition to \$3.7 million over five years to cease the asset sustainability levy introduced by the previous government.

South Australia High Productivity Vehicle network access

- The Commonwealth and State Governments have provided \$17 million for planning studies looking at the State-wide expansion of the HPV network.
- The proposal is to develop a high productivity road freight connection across South Australia from the Victorian border to the Western Australia border; including the Greater Adelaide Freight Corridor (Bypass) between the Port Wakefield Highway and Dukes Highway, via the Sturt Highway and Murray Bridge, for Performance Based Standards (PBS) Level 4 A vehicles [up to 53.5 metre A-triple combinations].
- The planning studies will deliver a Strategic Business Case (SBC) for the full suite of High Productivity Vehicle network access improvements. The SBC is well underway and is currently engaging with all key stakeholders from across industry to validate the initial assumptions made within the SBC and associated options. The SBC is expected to be completed end of 2023.

Lower Eyre Peninsula Overtaking Lanes - Scope and Status Update of Works

- The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$51.25 million as part of the Roads of Strategic Importance initiative to upgrade roads in the Lower Eyre Peninsula, following the closure of the Eyre Peninsula Rail Network.
- This currently requires agricultural produce to be transported by road to redistribution nodes or ports – increasing the dependence on selected roads.
- The funding was split across a number of priority projects, including overtaking lanes, intersection improvements, shoulder sealing and pavement works. The overtaking lane works included the construction of a total of four overtaking lanes on Lincoln Highway (two new overtaking lanes between Tumby Bay and Louth Bay), Flinders Highway and Western Approach Road, and planning work for an overtaking lane on the Tod Highway.
- The roads have been subject to traffic restrictions at different times to allow for repair works due to issues with the bituminous surfacing following adverse weather conditions. The contractor is responsible for completing all works at its cost.

For Official Use Only

- Ongoing monitoring is in place, with PW2PA Alliance staff on site a minimum of three days per week, to inspect all four project sites and to plan further interventions as required. The key aim of this is to keep interruptions to traffic to an absolute minimum through the remaining winter months.
- In addition to a range of communications and engagements regarding the remediation works required on the Flinders Highway and Western Approach, the PW2PA Alliance published an apology to the community in local papers on 13 July 2023 (Attachment 1). Further background information is provided below.
- The Port Wakefield to Port Augusta Alliance (PW2PA Alliance) has also delivered the upgraded following two intersections as part of the project:
 - o Pine Freezers Road and Western Approach Road; and
 - o Flinders Highway and Tod Highway.
- The project has delivered improved road safety, freight productivity and efficiency for road users, including holidaymakers travelling to seaside towns along the same transport corridors as heavy vehicles.

Eyre Peninsula Rail

- In April 2022, the Premier, Treasurer and Minister for Agriculture and Regions expressed support for rail in a meeting with Aurizon and Viterra.
- The Department coached Aurizon and Viterra through the Business Case development process to ensure it met Infrastructure Australia requirements and provided input relating to road network maintenance and upgrade aspects. However, the Department is not a party to the Business Case.
- With a benefit-cost ratio of 3.9, the Business Case identifies significant benefits and has been submitted for funding through the Federal Budget process.
- Before the Australian Government will consider funding, it is seeking an indication from the South Australian Government that the initiative is endorsed as a State priority.
- A letter of support to the Federal Minister for Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government is being prepared.

Intersection Upgrades

- As part of the ROSI program four key intersections will be upgraded along Lincoln Highway through central Port Lincoln:
- •
- o Flinders Highway/Light Street and Lincoln Highway/Hallett Place.
- o New West Road/Lewis Street and Hallett Place.
- o Hallett Place/Liverpool Street and Adelaide Place.
- o Liverpool Street and Mortlock Terrace/Bligh Street.
- The Department sought input throughout late 2022 from the community to help inform the design of the Port Lincoln Intersections safety upgrade. Works are expected to commence in early 2024.
- A project update is proved at Attachment 2 which provides further information on the upgrades.

- <u>Pavement upgrades</u>: as part of this program, pavement renewal works were undertaken along the main street (Lincoln Highway and Liverpool Street) and nearby locations in the centre of Port Lincoln, including the car parking bays. These works were delivered in conjunction with the City of Port Lincoln.
- The first stage of pavement renewal work on Liverpool Street, Porter Street, London Street and The Lebrun Street commenced in February 2023, and was completed in April 2023.
- The second stage of pavement renewal work on the Lincoln Highway, from Flinders Highway to Mortlock Terrace. These works will be undertaken in conjunction with the four planned intersection upgrades in early 2024.
- Note: the second stage of the pavement renewal works and intersection upgrades form part of the Federal Government's 90 day Infrastructure Investment Review.

Port Lincoln Town Jetty

• The Port Lincoln Town Jetty is owned by the Department and divested under lease to the City of Port Lincoln. Under the lease, which expires on 23 October 2025, Council is responsible for all aspects of maintenance and operation of the jetty.

- The recent budget announcement for the SA Jetties Renewal Program allocates \$20 million over four years, to address critical works across the State's jetties by providing assistance to councils to maintain these crucial community assets.
- The Department is currently progressing development of the SA Jetties Renewal Program, including defining eligibility criteria and the application process for your future consideration.
