

Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade

The Australian and South Australian governments have announced a reconfigured four way intersection will be constructed at the junctions of Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Roads to improve transport capacity and safety for all road users. The upgrade will also improve connectivity for vulnerable users and support adjoining land use.



Goodwood Road is one of southern Adelaide's major north-south arterial routes, with Springbank Road and Daws Road providing key east-west connection. Approximately 60,000 vehicles travel through the current intersections each day, with delays common during peak periods.

Prior to finalising the current design, the department investigated multiple options for this intersection. Following community feedback, new data and detailed costings, a realigned four-way intersection will be delivered.

About the demolition works

- The demolition works will be undertaken by one of the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure's prequalified contractors.

- These works will be undertaken along Springbank Road, Goodwood Road and Daws Road to facilitate the new intersection realignment.
- In addition to the demolition works, an asbestos assessment will be completed and any identified asbestos will be removed. All asbestos removal works will be carried out by a licensed asbestos contractor in accordance with the Environmental Protection Authority Guidelines. These measures will ensure the safety of the community and workers.
- Existing structures (i.e. garages and sheds) located on boundaries will be replaced with a 'like for like' fence, if required.
- The works will be undertaken in a staged approach as properties continue to become vacant across the project site.
- Prior to the demolition works starting, temporary fencing will be installed around properties for safety reasons and utility service disconnections will be undertaken.
- Security patrols will be engaged to maintain a presence throughout the project area. Police patrols will also monitor the project area and can be contacted on 131444, or 000 in an emergency situation.

Dust Management

Demolition works may create some short-term disturbance to nearby residents. Dust cannot be completely eliminated, however works will be managed to minimise the disturbance.
