Kroemer's Crossing Roundabout Project

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure is delivering the Kroemer's Crossing Roundabout Project, to improve safety for all road users and allow greater freight access to surrounding businesses.

This \$6 million project is funded by the Australian and South Australian Governments, The Barossa Council, and Pernod Ricard Winemakers Pty Ltd.

The project will deliver a single lane roundabout serving the multiple adjoining roads, which can accommodate vehicles up to 26 metres long, a shared use path on the western side of the roundabout, with pedestrian refuges across Murray Street and Barossa Valley Way, pedestrian ramps either side of Burings Road and safety barriers in some locations.

Works, including site set up will commence on 23 March 2020, on the eastern side of Barossa Valley Way, just north of Vine Vale Road. BMD Constructions are the main works contractor.

Some vegetation removals are required in order to deliver the works. This includes the removal of some large trees and several small trees and shrubs, including a large River Red Gum. Some roadside roses on Barossa Valley Way will also be removed. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to vegetation. No significant or regulated trees will be removed.

To facilitate construction of the roundabout, a temporary access road will be constructed to maintain access for road users. Menge Road will be closed to all through traffic for a period of time during construction. Properties on Menge Road can be accessed via Barossa Valley Way and Magnolia Street or via Vine Vale Road, Research Road and Magnolia Road.

Road users are asked to use extra caution when workers are on site, follow the direction of traffic management and observe traffic signage and speed restrictions when travelling through the area.

Some temporary pedestrian detours will be in place around the works site and pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community. DPTI encourages the community to continue to support local businesses during these works.
