

# Flagstaff Road Upgrade

## Site Investigation Works

Dear Resident/Business owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is continuing to plan for the widening of Flagstaff Road, Darlington.

We have received valuable feedback from community and business owners from the surveys and information sessions held last year. This feedback has been provided to our engineering and design consultants for consideration as the preferred concept is developed.

Investigation works to inform the development of a design will commence in May, including:

- Location of underground services.
- Geotechnical drilling, and
- Flora and fauna assessments along the road corridor.

If access is required to any properties for these investigations, we will contact the residents or business owners and property owners to discuss the nature of the investigative works that are planned and to obtain permission prior to investigations commencing.

Once these investigations have been completed and a preferred concept design has been determined, we will come back to you and the community to provide information about the outcomes of the study and the preferred design.
