

Grand Junction, Hampstead and Briens Road Intersection Upgrade

Night Works Notification

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is continuing works to upgrade the intersection of Grand Junction Road, Hampstead Road and Briens Road to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$19 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the South Australian and Australian governments.

While the majority of works are being undertaken during the day, night works are required to minimise the impact to traffic and ensure the works can be undertaken safely and efficiently.

Night works will continue through the school holiday period until Monday, 4 October 2021, weather permitting. Hours of works are between 7pm and 6am, Monday to Sunday. A respite night, where no works are undertaken, will be provided each week throughout these works.

Works during this time will be undertaken in stages on all approaches into the intersection and across the intersection. Works will include the installation of new traffic signal infrastructure and road lighting. Laying of new asphalt will also continue.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

The intersection will remain open with speed and lane restrictions in place.

Please plan ahead and allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions, detours and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout these works.

Public transport services will not be affected during these works, however if required, bus stops within the works area may be temporarily relocated. Advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at the bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website www.adelaidemetro.com.au.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Advance notice of future night works will be provided as works progress.

The Department appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
