New Park 'n' Ride

Dear Stakeholder,

The State Government is investing in a stronger public transport network and is committed to delivering increased connectivity, faster and more reliable travel options and increased use of public transport.

O-Bahn buses are the most popular public transport services in Adelaide, carrying more passengers on an average weekday than the most popular rail services.

In August 2020, the new Paradise Park 'n' Ride opened providing 815 car parking spaces, delivering on the State Government's commitment to expand parking facilities along the O-Bahn, and increase the use of public transport. The new Golden Grove Park 'n' Ride is currently under construction, which will deliver around 450 car parking spaces when completed.

The State Government has recently committed \$48.5 million for the construction of a new two-storey (ground floor, plus two upper floors) Park 'n' Ride facility at the Tea Tree Plaza Interchange. The project is expected to deliver around 500 additional parking spaces, to be confirmed as the design is developed, to support transport growth in the North Eastern suburbs.

To ensure the safety of road users, the works also include an upgrade to the Smart Road and access road junction, comprising the creation of a signalised T-junction.

The project aims to:

- improve attractiveness of public transport, by increasing the number of parking spaces available for public transport passengers;
- improve access to public transport;
- improve patronage of bus services; and
- improve passenger, vehicle and pedestrian accessibility.

The project is expected to commence construction early in 2022 and be complete in the second half of 2023.

Detailed investigations, planning and design work is required before construction begins.

Engagement with key stakeholders and the community will form an important component across the life of the project. In the coming months we will be organising opportunities to provide an update on the project and seek your feedback.
