King William Street and North Terrace Intersection night works

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of upcoming night works to be carried out at the intersection of King William Road and North Terrace as part of the City Tram Extension Project.

Weather permitting night works will occur from:

- **8pm on Thursday 8 February to 5am on Thursday 15 February; and**
- **11pm on Monday 19 February to 5am Wednesday 21 February.**

During these times tram services will be replaced with substitute buses between Victoria Square and the Entertainment Centre. For information about replacement bus services and updates about tram services, please call 1300 311 108 or visit www.adelaidemetro.com.au

Roads will remain open at all times, however, speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works. Right-turn movements will not be permitted through the intersection during the work period.

The works include installation of overhead electrical insulators, laying of overhead tram wires and underground cabling.

Access to businesses, carparks and properties will be maintained at all times.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby residents and businesses. However, some noise will be unavoidable during this period.
