## Majors Road and Seacombe Road bridges installation of permanent anti-throw screens



Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of weekend works on Southern Expressway bridges. These works are to install permanent anti-throw screens as part of DPTI's commitment to improve safety along the transport network.

Weekend works commenced on Friday, **7 December 2018** and are expected **to be completed by late February 2019**, weather permitting. Works will generally be undertaken from Fridays **at 7:00pm** and finish **on Mondays at 6:00am**.

**No weekend works will occur over the Christmas period from 22 December until 4 January 2019 and over the Santos Tour Down Under race weekend commencing 18 January 2019.**

### **Majors Road and Seacombe Road bridges works**

Majors Road and Seacombe Road bridges will be closed to all traffic with local traffic diversions in place **from Friday 11 January 2019 at 7:00pm until Monday 14 January 2019 at 6:00am**. These diversions are shown in yellow on the attached map.

The Southern Expressway will be closed to traffic between Main South Road, Sturt (Northern End of the expressway) and the Sheriffs Road Interchange.

Motorists travelling south on the expressway will be diverted via Main South Road and will be able to access the Expressway from the Sheriffs Road Interchange. This diversion is shown in orange on the attached map.

North bound motorists need to exit via the Sheriffs Road Interchange and continue using Main South Road. This diversion is shown in blue on the attached map.

Road users are advised to follow the direction of traffic management staff and observe VMS boards and local traffic management signage. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to nearby pedestrian bridges or road bridges.

Existing bus routes will continue to operate as normal and will not be diverted.

**Access to businesses and properties will be maintained at all times.**

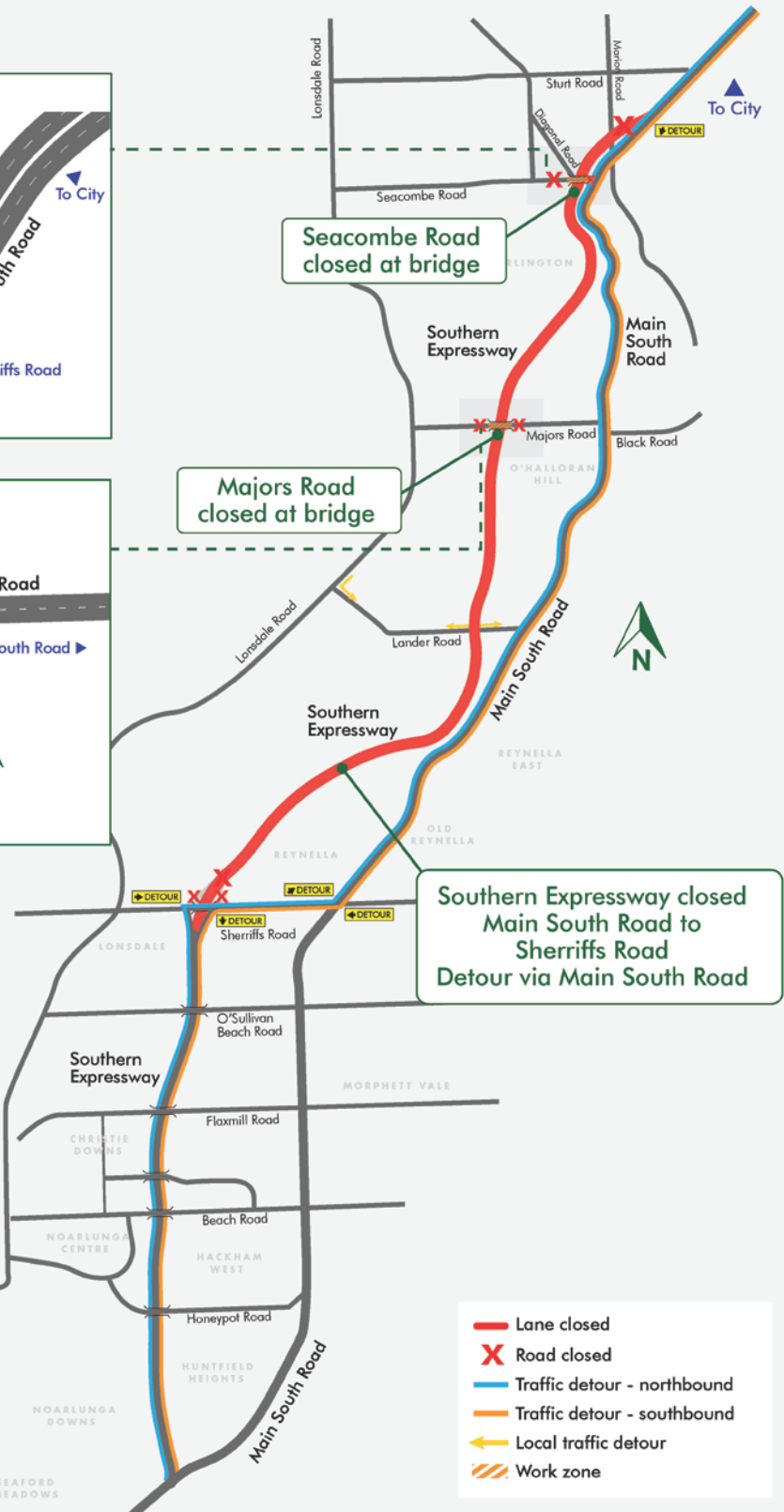
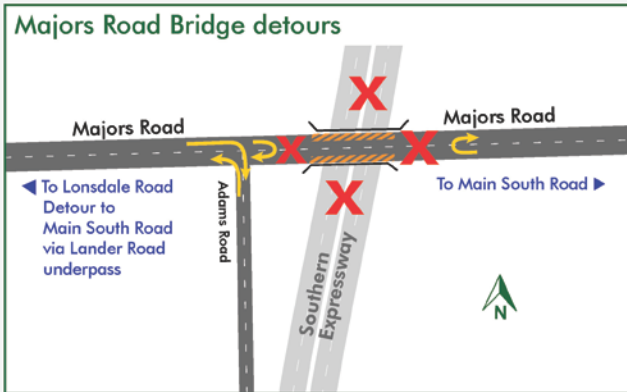
