

Regional Bridges Upgrade Project

Lyndoch Bridge

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is upgrading the Lyndoch Bridge, located on the Barossa Valley Way between Lyndoch and Tanunda, as part of the \$40 million Australian Government and State Government funded Regional Bridges Upgrade Program.

Works on the Lyndoch Bridge are scheduled to **commence on Friday, 22 February, and are expected to be completed by July**, weather permitting, and will involve:

- replacing the existing bridge and culvert with wider structures
- installation of new guard rails and bridge barriers

Works will be undertaken **from 7am to 5pm, Monday morning to Saturday afternoon** each week until the completion of the project.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times throughout the works and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users wherever possible.

Traffic diversions and speed restrictions will be in place with detours as shown on the attached map, for all traffic throughout the works.

Road users are advised to follow the direction of traffic management staff and observe signage.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.


