

Mitcham Hills Planning Study

The Australian and South Australian Governments are jointly undertaking improvements to the Mitcham hills road corridor. As part of this commitment, a planning study has started for Old Belair Road and Shepherds Hill Road /Main Road.

The study will focus on opportunities to improve access, travel times and safety for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists:

- along Old Belair Road, with a focus on the intersections of Main Road/ Russell Street and Old Belair Road/James Road
- along Shepherds Hill Road (between the Blackwood roundabout and Brighton Parade/Waite Street) and Main Road (between the Blackwood roundabout and Edward Street/Carr Street).

You can participate through an online survey, and by meeting our project team at one of the pop-up information sessions listed below.

Your feedback will be used to inform concept plans, which will be released in the first half of 2020.



The survey is open until 14 February 2020.

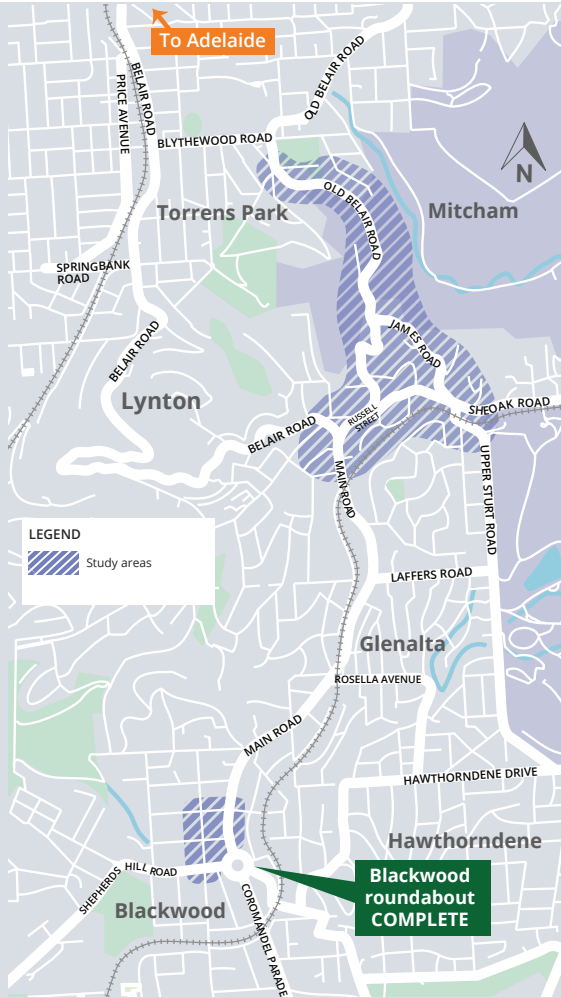
