The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) advises that the surface of Reservoir Road could be considered for resurfacing.

However, the overall condition of the road is considered to be acceptable and resurfacing works are not programmed at this time.

Please be assured that all roads under the care, control and management of the Department are regularly inspected with any minor repairs made to ensure the road is maintained in a safe condition for all road users.

The Department advises that a traffic survey was undertaken at the Reservoir Road/Smart Road intersection in November 2022. This provided data on all traffic movements at this intersection.

Additionally, earlier in 2022, a traffic survey was undertaken to the south at the Reservoir Road/Grand Junction Road signalised intersection. Both of these surveys provided information on the traffic movements to/from Reservoir Road, at both the Smart Road and Grand Junction Road ends, as well as traffic volumes on Reservoir Road.

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) advises that technicians attended the site on 21 February 2023 and found a faulty Audio Tactile push button device. The faulty device has since been replaced and all push buttons with audible warning sound at the intersection were tested and are now working correctly.

Thank you for your letter dated 23 January 2023, on behalf of Mr Personal Affairs about his experiences on the public transport network.

I note Mr (1)- also provided his feedback through the Adelaide Metro website. Please be assured that all feedback is registered and is forwarded to the relevant service provider or area within the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) for appropriate action.

The Department referred Mr Personal concerns regarding the reliability of the route 541X bus service to the service provider, Torrens Transit, for investigation.

Torrens Transit has advised the following:

- On 29 November 2022, the 541X service ran on time as per timetabled to the City. Data shows the 541X service departed the previous timepoint (stop 50 Hancock Road) at 7.16am and arrived at stop 43D Smart Road at 7.22am.
- On 30 November 2022, the 541X failed to operate due a shortage of driver resources on this day.
- On 1 December 2022, the driver clipped a kerb and damaged the guidewheel enroute to the City. The bus was changed over at Tea Tree Plaza prior to its entry to the O-Bahn track.

Torrens Transit would like to sincerely apologise to Mr Clause 6 for the inconvenience caused when services did not run to schedule, making him arrive later at work than his usual start time.

Regarding the roadway at the Tea Tree Plaza Interchange, I am advised the Department conducted maintenance at the end of January 2023, to rectify the unevenness of the surface.

The Department further advises that Adelaide Metro Tap and Pay is being introduced to Adelaide's public transport network in stages and is currently only available on trams and O-Bahn buses.

As Mr (1) = has noted, the Tap and Pay validators are available on the middle and rear doors of O-Bahn buses. This is a measure to allow the validators compatible with paper metro tickets to remain at the front of buses during this transition period.

The next phase of this roll out is the replacement of the front validator with smart validators on non-O-Bahn buses followed by the remaining front door validators on O-Bahn buses.

Further information regarding Adelaide Metro Tap and Pay is available at: www.adelaidemetro.com.au/tickets-and-fares/tap-and-pay.

Mr Personal feedback regarding people boarding buses from any door is noted and it is acknowledged that not all intending passengers who have lined up are able to have first access to a seat like they would through entry only via the front door.

The Department advises that the implementation of all door boardings on O-Bahn services has reduced boarding times in the City and at key interchanges, thus improving service reliability and travel times. As such, the Department has no plans to return to entry only through the front door of O-Bahn buses.

Thank you for your letter dated 15 November 2022, on behalf of Mr Personal Affairs regarding access to documents about the former State Transport Authority and TransAdelaide; and bus planning. I apologise for the delay in responding to you.

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) supports Mr Personal viewing historical public transport information, in accordance with the State Records Act 1997, as do I.

In the first instance, Mr (1). There heeds to contact State Records requesting to access historical public transport records. State Records can be contacted at: (archives.sa.gov.au/general-information/contact-us/contact-us).

If the records Mr (1)- requires are found within State Records' holding and are restricted from public access, then State Records will contact the Department to review the records.

If there are records that Mr (1) would like to view, he would need to contact the State Records Research Centre to arrange an appointment.

I note Mr (1) comments about bus and have asked Mr Scott White, Executive Director, South Australian Public Transport Authority to contact Mr (1) and discuss his concerns.

The Malinauskas Labor Government is committed to improving public transport services across the network. The 2022-2023 State Budget delivered:

- \$19 million to improve transport and support growth in Mount Barker and the Adelaide Hills
- \$12 million to establish a new dedicated express service fleet and depot,
- \$6 million to expand the Park 'n' Ride at Crafers
- \$1 million to undertake planning for a Bridgewater Park 'n' Ride.
- 2022-2023 Mid Year Budget Review committed \$2.8 million for a Lightsview Go Zone.

In relation to the reversal of the train and tram privatisation election commitment, the two operators, Keolis Downer Adelaide and Torrens Connect, have agreed to work collaboratively with the Government in meeting its election commitment and negotiations are ongoing.

The Department is also undertaking a feasibility into the return of metropolitan bus services back into Government control, which is expected to be completed soon.

Thank you for your correspondence dated 21 March 2023 on behalf of Mr egarding temporarily blocking access to his licence details.

A driver's licence is often used by organisations such as financial institutions and telecommunications providers to confirm a person's identity. These organisations utilise the Document Verification Service (DVS), a secure national online system to verify identity documents, including a driver's licence. Customers affected by the Latitude Financial Services data breach have the option to present to a Service SA Centre to obtain a replacement licence and the usual replacement licence fee of \$20.00 will be waived.

When a licence card is replaced, the licence number remains the same, however the card number will change. The card number, known as the Card Identification Number (CIN), is a unique security number on the back of the driver's licence. However, if the client requests the change of his/her license number as well, this can also be provided.

Replacing the licence and updating the CIN protects customers from unauthorised DVS checks using the previous driver's licence details. When verifying a driver's licence, the DVS requires both the driver's licence number and the card identification number to be provided and matched. If the licence has been replaced or renewed since the licence details were provided to the organisation that has suffered a data breach, there may not be a need to replace the driver's licence.

The temporary block to access of licence details by Service SA, that Mr Claus s suggesting will not resolve the breach risk. The most appropriate action for any person who is concerned about the risks involved in being part of a data breach is to replace their licence.

I asked the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) to refer Mr Clause 6 concerns to the Torrens Transit, the contracted operator of the O-Bahn bus services, for a response.

Torrens Transit advised they were first made aware of Mr clause 6 concerns lodged through Adelaide Metro. The St Agnes Operations Supervisor contacted Mr Clause on 23 February 2023, advising that his trip did not operate due to operational issues.

Regarding other O-Bahn service delays Mr raises, as there are no specific details provided such as dates, times or routes, Torrens Transit is not able to investigate further.

However, it is worth noting that driver resource constraints are currently impacting public transport services. The Government is working to reinstate regular bus timetables as soon as possible.

Notwithstanding, it is regrettable when services do not run to schedule and I apologise to Mr Clause for any inconvenience he has been experiencing on these occasions.

Please note when the contractor does not meet is obligational KPI's, they face significant financial abatements and other remediation to ensure poor performance and service disruptions are rectified as a priority for the South Australian community.
