

# Wynn Vale Drive and Bridge Road Junction Upgrade

Project update

## We are upgrading the junction of Wynn Vale Drive and Bridge Road in Gulfview Heights

This forms part of the State Government's election commitment to upgrade, or investigate potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs.

### **Project Update**

Works to upgrade the junction of Wynn Vale Drive and Bridge Road in Gulfview Heights are underway. To date, we have completed the installation of new light pole footings, street lighting, new traffic signal conduit crossings and pit installations. We are also removing old asphalt to prepare the road for new pavement.

During construction a previously unidentified SA Water main pipeline was located within the work zone. Temporary protection works are required prior to the pipeline being relocated to facilitate the next phase of major works. SA Water will undertake required service relocation works concurrently with our project works, please see overleaf for more information.

Due to these additional works, project completion is now expected in late 2025.

#### What's next?

Wynn Vale Drive is scheduled to reopen to traffic early July 2025, weather permitting.

Upcoming works on Bridge Road will include construction of new stormwater infrastructure, installation of light poles and the creation of an indented bus bay on the north bound side of Bridge Road.

To facilitate the construction of stormwater infrastructure across the roadway, Melville Road will be closed at night at the junction of Bridge Road in mid July 2025 for approximately one week. Melville Road will reopen during the day with some speed restrictions. Local access detours will be in place during the closure. Please follow the direction of onsite traffic controllers and observe signage.

To keep everyone safe, existing speed and lane restrictions will remain in place while works are underway.

Access to buses will be maintained, however, please check the latest updates on scheduled services at <u>adelaidemetro.com.au</u>

During the works, there may be some noise, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

#### **SA Water works**

SA Water will undertake required relocation works over the coming months. To safely facilitate these works there will be impacts to sections of the Shared Use Path in the reserve between Wynn Vale Drive and Cornwall Drive. Pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place during this time, please follow onsite signage.

SA Water will contact customers directly for any service impacts that may occur during their relocation works.
