

Grand Junction, Hampstead and Briens Road Intersection Upgrade

Early Works Notification

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) will be upgrading the intersection of Grand Junction, Hampstead and Briens Road to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$19 million project is jointly funded by the South Australian and Australian Governments.

As part of the project, DPTI advises that service relocation works will be undertaken along Grand Junction Road, Hampstead Road and Briens Road to facilitate the intersection upgrade. These works will be undertaken in stages.

Timing of works:

Service relocation works are expected to commence from Wednesday, 24 June 2020, with completion expected by the end of 2020, weather permitting. The majority of works will be undertaken during the day, Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm, with some weekend works.

Intermittent night works may be required, between 7pm and 7am, in order to minimise traffic impacts and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently. Advance notice will be provided as works progress.

Major construction on the intersection upgrade is expected to commence early 2021, with project completion expected in early 2022.

Upcoming activities:

Service relocation works will include, APA Gas works, relocation of SA Power Networks 66kV & 11kV infrastructure, SA Water asset alterations and the relocation of telecommunications infrastructure.

Some vegetation along the project corridor will be required to be removed to facilitate these works. Prior to any removals, the work area will be inspected on site by a suitably qualified flora and fauna specialist and where required, fauna will be relocated to a similar habitat. Impacts will be minimised, as much as practically possible.

What to expect:

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access for properties will also be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
