

Flinders Link Project

Temporary closure of Woodland Road at the junction with Handley Avenue

15 and 16 September 2020

As part of the \$141 million Flinders Link Project, a new Activated Pedestrian Crossing is being established south of the new Tonsley Railway Station. Works to support the delivery of the crossing include the installation of precast concrete panels over two days, weather permitting.

To safely facilitate these works a **temporary closure of Woodland Road at its junction with Handley Avenue** will be required **between 7am and 5pm on Tuesday, 15 September 2020, and Wednesday, 16 September 2020.**

Alternative access will be maintained via Bradley Grove with traffic restrictions in place while these works are undertaken.

Traffic controllers will be onsite to direct road users and ensure access for residents. In the interest of safety, pedestrians are reminded to keep clear of the work zones and observe signage.

Please take extra care when workers are onsite and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic restrictions when travelling through the area.
