



# Cross Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

## Early works update

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly (50:50) committed \$61 million to upgrade the Cross Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability. This project is being delivered by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department).

The detailed design is currently being updated and will be provided to the community in the coming months. Please see below an update on early works for the project. These activities are required irrespective of the final design.

### Demolition works

Demolition works are underway to facilitate the intersection upgrade. These works are expected to be completed in early 2022, weather permitting.

### Utility services relocation works

Early service relocation works are planned to commence from Monday, 27 September 2021, with completion in April 2022, weather permitting.

The majority of works will be undertaken Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm, with some weekend works.

In order to minimise traffic impacts and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently, some night works may also be required. Advance notice will be provided as works progress.

Works will include the relocation of some SA Power Networks and telecommunications infrastructure.

Some vegetation will also need to be removed to facilitate these works. Prior to any removals, the work area will be inspected on site by a suitably qualified flora and fauna specialist and where required, fauna will be relocated to a similar habitat. Impacts will be minimised, as much as practically possible.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access for properties will also be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

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Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Individual service providers, including SA Power Networks and Telecommunications providers, will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.
