Gawler Rail Electrification Project

Track resurfacing activities within the rail corridor

The Gawler Rail Electrification Project will be undertaking essential track works along the Gawler rail line, between 6pm Wednesday, 13 October and 6am Thursday 14 October 2021, weather permitting.

The works will be within the rail corridor, in the vicinity of your property, between Howard Street, Gawler and Gawler Central Railway Station. The works involve compacting the ballast stones under the railway lines through a process called 'tamping'.

As the crews move along the railway line, medium to high levels of noise can be expected when the tamping machinery is in close proximity to your property.

While tamping can be noisy and dusty, it is required to ensure durability of the track, improve the ride quality of trains and is an important part of ensuring good track condition.

You may experience high-level vibration and hear noise from rail equipment, machinery, vehicle movements and essential communication between workers, however every effort will be made to minimise disruption to residents during these works.
