

# Mitcham Hills Road Corridor Upgrade

## Russell Street, Main Road and Sheoak Road junction ongoing works

**The South Australian Government is upgrading the Russell Street, Main Road and Sheoak Road junction.**

In order to minimise the impact to road users and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently, early works will continue to be undertaken both during the day and at night, intermittently. These early works are expected to be complete in late April, weather permitting.

### What to expect

Service relocation works which commenced in February 2023, are continuing with completion expected in late April 2023, weather permitting. Works will include the relocation of telecommunications infrastructure, APA Gas works and SA Water main alterations. Individual service providers will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.

Night works will now include Fridays, with works to be undertaken between 7pm and 6am, Sunday to Friday. As previously advised, no works will be undertaken on Saturday nights. Daytime work hours will continue to be between 7am and 7pm Monday to Saturday. As previously, no day works will be undertaken on Sunday during the day.

**The junction will remain open to traffic at all times while these works are undertaken.**

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling more intrusive works in the early evening.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. Access to properties will be maintained throughout these works. No changes to public transport services are planned during these works.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
