Potts Road Upgrade Concept Design

Dear Resident/Property Owner,

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to provide you with an update on the Gawler East Link Project.

As part of the preparation for construction, our project team consulted with the community and stakeholders to provide feedback prior to the design phase commencing.

This feedback has been incorporated into the design, which is now at 30% completion.

As a result of the feedback the project team has reviewed the original design for Potts Road and identified alternative treatments to increase its functionality and improve safety and amenity. The changes from the original design are reductions in lane and median widths, resulting in a decreased overall road width on Potts Road.

Project benefits include:

- New Disability Discrimination Act (DDA) compliant footpaths and road crossings
- Upgraded road lighting
- Dedicated bike lanes
- Safe right turn storage capacity for access into properties
- Maximised number of on-street car parking (approximately 42 parks)
- Inclusion of a “spoon drain” between the road and car parks to
 - Reduce impacts on driveways and existing services
 - Improve stormwater drainage
 - Improve visibility to allow road users to differentiate between the road and the parking bays
- Increased opportunities for landscaping along Potts Road
