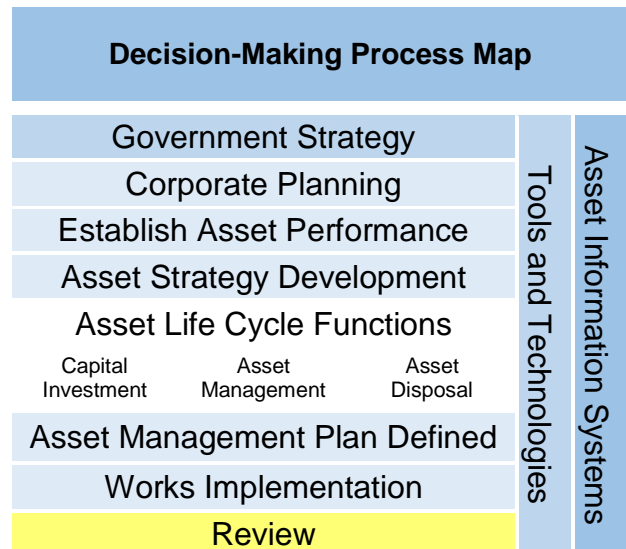
DPTI Process Overview



The Review Phase is to ensure the effectiveness of practices and where appropriate, identify opportunities for improvement of processes are in place. It also offers an opportunity to measure the performance of the asset portfolio.

Management Process Reviews

Management process reviews address specific issues of probity and accountability by checking that due process has been observed. [Post Construction Reviews](#) provide an example of such reviews and provide management feedback to improve future project delivery, e.g. project objectives, project briefs, specifications and documentation. Process reviews search for evidence that appropriate records have been maintained and that an effective audit trail exists.



Asset Performance Reviews

Reviews associated with performance of an asset or asset portfolio include Post Occupancy Evaluation to test a new project against its brief and [Asset Performance Reviews](#). The latter measure the performance of existing assets against a range of indicators including location, level of utilisation, functionality, built environment, physical condition and financial efficiency.
