

Regional Bridges Upgrade Project

Stott Highway Bridge

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) is upgrading the Stott Highway Bridge located between Keyneton and Sedan, as part of the \$40 million Australian Government and State Government funded Regional Bridges Upgrade Program.

Works on the Stott Highway Bridge are scheduled to commence on Friday, **22 February**, and are **expected to be completed in July**, weather permitting, and will involve:

- replacing the existing bridge with wider structures
- installation of new guard rails and bridge barriers

Works will be undertaken **from 7am to 5pm, Monday morning to Saturday afternoon** each week until the completion of the project.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times throughout the works and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users wherever possible.

Traffic will be diverted around the work site under a speed restriction via a temporary diversion road, which has been constructed adjacent to the bridge structure (refer attached map).

Road users are advised to follow the direction of traffic management staff and observe signage.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.


