

# SAMIS Build 13.22

## Overview

The SAMIS Build Initiatives & Enhancements Communication Bulletin contains information about business and system changes that have occurred and been deployed into SAMIS production.

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## Details of Enhancements

In SAMIS Build 13.22 the following expected benefits were deployed into SAMIS production:

- **SE-160 Documents & Images Search Functionality**  
A filtering option has now been added to the Documents & Images page for all columns. A new column for Document Category has also been added (e.g. Building Plan)\*.
- **SE-179 SAMIS Passwords Not Case-Sensitive**  
A change has been introduced to ensure that SAMIS passwords are case-sensitive and contain both a capital and a number in line with standard ICT policy.
- **SE-178 New Client Supervisor Field in SAMIS User Admin Screen**  
A new field has been added to the User Administration screen to record the user's SAMIS access approving officer.
- **SE-184 Attribute History Button Moved to Asset Details Screen**  
The Attribute History functionality has been moved to the main Asset Details screen, allowing easier access to an asset's attribute history.
- **SE-140 Updating of Lifecycle Cost with an Override Factor**  
When an asset has had a replacement cost added to it with the override box ticked, this cost can become out of date over time. This change allows SAMIS Administrators to update these costs by a set percentage (e.g. CPI).
- **SE-176 New Code Table showing Previous Code Table Values**  
A fix has been implemented for when a new code table in SAMIS was showing a previously viewed code table's values.

- **SE-169 Addition of “Export to Excel” for Hazardous Materials Register**  
Addition of an “Export to Excel” button for the Hazardous Materials Register.
  - **SE-182 Serviced Location for HWS & HVAC on Fast Data Entry**  
Addition of functionality to assign the locations a Hot Water Service (HWS) or Heating Ventilation and Air Conditioning asset services on the Fast Data Entry screen.
  - **SE-190 SAMIS Password Reset Issue – Expired Accounts**  
A fix has been implemented to fix issues where SAMIS Administrators could not reset some users’ passwords.
