Dear Resident/Business Proprietor

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of night works along North Terrace, between King William Road and East Terrace as part of the City Tram Extension. The extension forms Stage One of the EastLINK, with future stages planned to the eastern suburbs through Kent Town. The extension is also the first step in the CityLINK loop around the CBD.

Night works are scheduled to commence from **Tuesday 14 March** and be completed by **Tuesday 21 March 2017**, weather permitting. The works will occur between the hours of 7pm to 5am. There will be no works occurring on the weekend of 18 and 19 March 2017.

The works involve service investigations to provide important information for the detailed design of the Project.

These works are being undertaken at night in order to minimise the impact to road users and to complete as safely and efficiently as possible.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the road will remain open to traffic in both directions at all times. A 25 km/h speed restriction will be in place while workers are on site.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby businesses and residents. However, some noise will be unavoidable during this period.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
