North Terrace Intersection weekend works: January 2018

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of upcoming weekend works along North Terrace at the Pulteney Street and the Gawler Place intersections, as part of the City Tram Extension Project.

The **Pulteney Street intersection** works are scheduled to commence from **10pm on Friday 19 January** and will be completed by **6am on Monday 22 January 2018**, weather permitting.

The **Gawler Place intersection** works are scheduled to commence from **11pm on Friday 26 January** and will be completed by **6am on Monday 29 January**, weather permitting.

Roads will remain open at all times, however, speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works. Right-turn movements will not be permitted through the intersections during the work periods.

The works include excavating, loading and removal of dirt, preparing and laying of tram tracks and concrete pouring.

Access to businesses, carparks and properties will be maintained at all times.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby residents and businesses. However, some noise will be unavoidable during this period.
