Port Wakefield Road, Bolivar – night works and ongoing speed restriction

As part of the Northern Connector Project, the Department of Planning Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises there will be night works and ongoing speed restrictions on Port Wakefield Road for the construction of the Bolivar Interchange.

Location: Port Wakefield Road, between Hodgson and Bolivar Roads, Bolivar (refer to map).

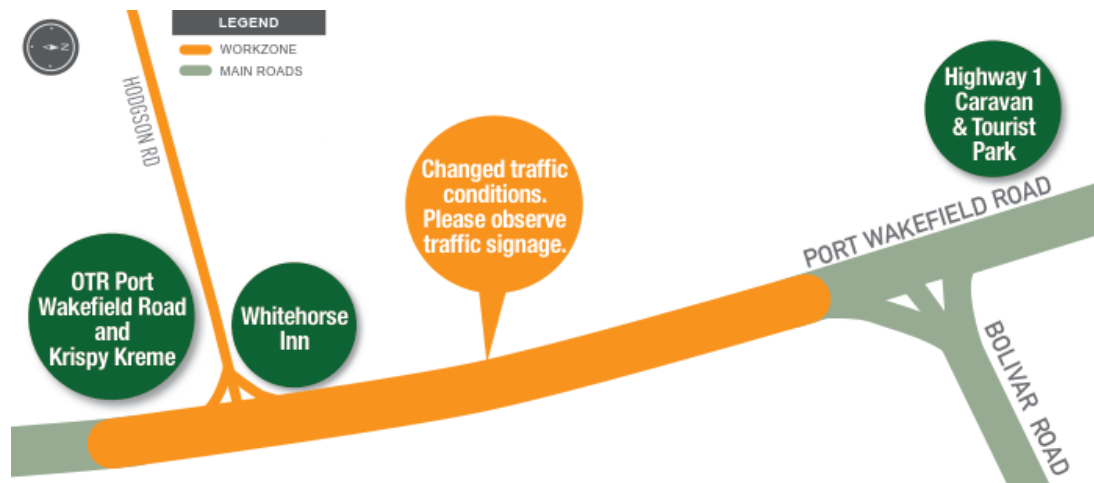
Commencing: Monday 28 May 2018, for approximately 5 nights, weather permitting. No weekend or Friday night work will take place.

Work hours: Between 8pm and 5am.

Activities: Line marking and placement of road safety barriers to continue the construction of the Bolivar Interchange.

Traffic management: Traffic will be reduced to a single lane in each direction utilising the southbound carriageway under managed traffic conditions. Access to businesses will be maintained at all times. Signage and traffic management will be in place to advise motorists of changed conditions.

Following these works, all north and south bound lanes will resume operation, with northbound lanes operating under a 60km/h speed restriction to safely accommodate the construction of the Bolivar Interchange (due for completion late 2019).
