

Darlington Upgrade Project

South Road traffic restrictions, St Marys 20 - 21 July

As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project, traffic restrictions will be in place on South Road between Lloyd Street and Brookman Avenue, St Marys, from 5am Saturday 20 July until 5pm Sunday 21 July.

The restrictions are required for the installation of a safety barrier on South Road between the lowered motorway and the southbound surface road.

Traffic restrictions

- Quinlan Avenue will be temporarily closed at South Road.
- Traffic on South Road through the work area will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Traffic in both directions will run on the northbound carriageway of South Road.
- The right turn out of Tonsley Boulevard onto South Road will not be permitted.

Please refer to the plan overleaf for details.

Access to all properties will be maintained. Please follow on-site signage for access to local businesses.

A profiler, crane, excavator, asphalt truck and lighting towers will be used. Some noise can be expected while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise impacts as much as possible.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place during the works, and motorists are advised to take care when driving through the area. The works are weather dependant so may need to be rescheduled in the case of excessive rain.
