



Stebonheath Road Closure Notice

Womma Road and Stebonheath Road Intersection, Edinburgh North

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport is installing a single lane roundabout at the intersection of Stebonheath Road and Womma Road, Edinburgh North to improve road safety and traffic efficiency for all road users.

As part of these works Stebonheath Road will be temporarily closed at the junction of Womma Road.

The junction will be closed at all times from Tuesday, 6 April 2021, until the completion of works in late July 2021, weather permitting.

Road users are encouraged to follow the detours as per the attached map, and the onsite detour signage and traffic management directions.

Womma Road will remain open at all times, however traffic will be unable to turn left or right from Womma Road into Stebonheath Road.

A 25kmph speed restriction will be in place while workers are on-site and 40kmph at other times. Lane and other speed restrictions may apply, subject to onsite conditions.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

There is no impact to public transport and services will continue to operate as normal on Womma Road. Emergency service vehicles will be required to utilise the detour and have been advised of the traffic restrictions of the works. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to use caution in the vicinity of the works and follow directions from traffic controllers and signage.
