

Road Resurfacing Works

Freeling Township

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport is undertaking road resurfacing works, including profiling, asphaltting and line marking on Stephenson Street, Templers Road, and Hanson Street in the township of Freeling. These works are being undertaken to improve the safety and amenity of the road for all users.

What to expect

Works will involve removing existing pavement and replacing it with new asphalt to ensure the long-term safety and integrity of the road for all road users. Works are scheduled to commence on Saturday, 24 June 2023 and are expected to be completed on Friday, 30 June 2023 (weather permitting). Works will be undertaken between the hours of 7am and 7pm. No works will be undertaken on Sundays.

To safely facilitate these works, **Stephenson Street will be closed from Hanson Street to Peake Street for the duration of the works.** Motorists will be required to detour via Hanson Street, Clarke Street and Peake Street (see map overleaf).

During work hours, **Templers Road will be temporarily reduced to a single lane of traffic** between Kernich Road and Borrow Street, with temporary traffic signals in place to control the flow of traffic. Speed restrictions will also be in place throughout the work area.

Outside of work hours, Stephenson Street will remain closed to traffic. Templers Road between Kernich Road and Borrow Street will be open to traffic in both directions. Speed restrictions will remain in place outside of working hours. Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site.

Access will be maintained for emergency services at all times. Access to properties will be maintained during the works wherever possible, with advance notice to be provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access. **Access to the Freeling Hotel will be maintained via Hanson Street.**

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative routes. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance as much as practically possible.
