

Princes Highway Corridor Upgrades

Bells Road - temporary closure and detour

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users. The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening:

Works to construct new northbound and southbound overtaking lanes approximately nine kilometres north of Millicent is underway. Prior to completion of works, bituminous surface works are required.

How this affects you:

Final pavement and bituminous surfacing works will commence from Monday, 8 January 2024. To do this work safely, we'll have speed and lane restrictions in work areas. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs. Outside of work hours speed restriction will remain in place subject to onsite conditions.

To safely undertake a portion of these works **Bells Road (Argyle Road) will be temporarily closed at the junction with the Princes Highway from Monday 22 January 2024 until late February 2024**, weather permitting. Please see detour map overleaf.

Speed restrictions will remain in place until line marking is finished which is set to be completed in early March 2024, weather permitting.

No works will be undertaken between Friday, 22 December 2023 and Sunday, 7 January 2024.
