

Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

Roundabout upgrades, Mount Gambier

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users.

The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening

We are upgrading the roundabout at the intersection of Wehl Street North and Jubilee Highway West.

How this affects you

Works are continuing with traffic restrictions in place when required to keep everyone safe. This may include onsite traffic controllers to help manage the flow of traffic.

Works requiring the temporary closure of the northern access to and from Jubilee Highway West and Wehl Street North have been rescheduled. This is due to a programming change as a result of the inclement weather in late 2023.

Works are continuing, with temporary road closures in place from March 2024, with advance notice to be provided.
