Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

The Springs Road/Burrungule Road Intersection Upgrade

We're improving long term safety, connectivity and efficiency for all road users on the Princes Highway.

The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening

We are undertaking works on the Princes Highway and at the intersection with The Springs Road and Burrungule Road.

Works are ongoing in the area however due to a number of program impacts, including inclement weather, the previously notified pavement works requiring a detour at the intersection have been postponed. These intersection works will now take place in mid-September 2024 with advance notice provided closer to the time.

Pavement asphalting works on the Princes Highway, in the vicinity of the intersection will commence in mid-August 2024 with all works complete, including the intersection in late October 2024, weather permitting.

How this affects you

To undertake these works safely, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the area as required. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however we will minimise disturbance, as much as practically possible. You might also notice some odours when travelling through the area, which is normal during asphalt works.

Princes Highway will remain open at all times with speed restrictions in place outside of working hours.
