AGFMA provides updates to Facilities Management Governance Group (FMGG) Members and Agency Representatives on the COVID-19 Pandemic, as it relates to the Facilities Management (FM) Services.

Below is an update on the recent changes since the last Bulletin:

New Site Entry Form – COVID -19

Site Access Entry Form - COVID-19

A recent State Emergency Directives allowing travellers from Western Australia, Northern Territory, Queensland and Tasmania to no longer self-isolate on arrival in SA has triggered the Site Access Entry Form to be updated. Currently interstate visitors from Victoria, NSW and ACT are required to self-isolate for 14 days. See here for latest [Cross-border travel](#) information.

As previously advised for the duration of the COVID-19 Outbreak, Agencies that receive facilities management services via the AGFMA should assess and implement the Site Access protocols for FM Service Provider' and sub-contractors entering designated locations.

A revised [Site Entry Form – COVID-19](#) should be distributed to your network for implementation within your existing site induction processes.

Further updates of the Site Entry Form – COVID-19 may be issued as State Emergency Directives are announced.

Definition for essential travellers

Agencies are alerted to the new definition for Essential Travellers issued on 24 June 2020. Where applicable, it is recommended that you consider the new directive, if relevant to your operations, and provide direction within your Agency.

For AGFMA: Essential Travellers providing services in the metropolitan and regional areas will be classified in accordance with [Schedule 2](#).

For APY lands: Essential Travellers will be classified in accordance with [Schedule 1](#).

FM Service Providers have been made aware of the changes and requested to implement where appropriate.
