

# City Light Pole Replacement

Dear Resident / Business Owner

Further to our previous notification in October, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is progressing with the replacement of light poles on King William Road and North Terrace along the Botanic tram line. These works are expected to be completed this weekend, weather permitting.

Traffic management and localised detours will be in place for these works this weekend (1am Saturday, 28 November to 4:30 am Monday, 30 November), and will require the closure of sections of North Terrace in one direction as follows:

## Saturday, 28 November:

- 1am - 4am, East Terrace to Frome Street (closed for westbound traffic)
- 4am - 7am, Frome Street to Pulteney Street (closed for westbound traffic)
- 7am - 7pm, Pulteney Street to Frome Street (closed for eastbound traffic)
- 7pm - 10pm, Frome Street to Pulteney Street (closed for westbound traffic)
- 10pm - 7am (Sunday, 29 November), Pulteney Street to Austin Street (closed for westbound traffic)

## Sunday, 29 November:

- 7am - 3.30pm, Kintore Avenue to Pulteney Street (closed for eastbound traffic)
- 3.30pm - 7pm, Frome Road to East Terrace (closed for eastbound traffic)
- 7pm - 4am (Monday, 30 November), Gawler Place to King William Street (closed for westbound traffic)

**Tram services on the Botanic line will not operate during the weekend works.**

**Access to businesses will be maintained and the community is encouraged to support local business.** The Department will continue to work with retailers and local service providers to deliver this project with the least possible disruption.
