

## South Eastern Freeway Pavement Rehabilitation – Toll Gate to Heysen Tunnels – Night works

Stage 1 Works, 15 February – 1 March 2021

The South Eastern Freeway pavement rehabilitation Stage 1 works will be undertaken from Monday, 15 February until Monday, 1 March 2021, weather permitting.

These works will be undertaken on the citybound lanes of the freeway, between the western side of the Heysen Tunnels and the eastern side of the Mount Osmond Road Bridge, Leawood Gardens.

#### Times of works

To safely facilitate the works and minimise impact to road users the works will be undertaken at night from Sunday to Friday at the following times:

- Monday to Friday between 7pm and 6am
- Friday evening works will continue to 8am Saturday
- Sunday evening from 5pm to 6am Monday

In the event of extreme fire danger conditions, no works will be undertaken.

### What to expect

During the night works the normal citybound lanes of the freeway in this location will be temporarily closed, with all vehicles directed onto the other side of the freeway (which is the normal uptrack). One lane of traffic will operate in the uphill direction, and two lanes will operate in the downhill direction.

During the night works, speeds for downhill traffic will be restricted to 40 km/h from around the Stirling Interchange. Speeds for uphill traffic will be restricted to 40km/h through the work zone and will then return to the posted speed beyond the works, as signed.

During the day there will still be speed and lane restriction in the citybound (downhill direction) lanes. A single lane closure will be in place through the work area and a 60 km/h speed restriction will be in place on the downhill lanes of the freeway from the Measdays Bridge. This is to allow heavy vehicles and light vehicles to be travelling at the same speed prior to the citybound lane closure.



The Mount Barker Road citybound on-ramp at Leawood Gardens will be closed from 15 February 2021 at 7pm and remain closed 24 hours a day until Monday, 22 February 2021 at 6am, weather permitting. From Monday, 22 February through to Monday, 1 March 2021, the citybound on-ramp will be closed only during night works.

Vehicles will be required to detour via Mount Barker Road and enter the freeway at the Crafers Interchange in order to travel city bound. Please see the maps overleaf for details.

Variable Message Signs will be in place at key locations to provide early notice to motorists of the traffic restrictions.

Motorists should expect delays, so please plan ahead and allow additional travel time.

Heavy vehicles, including buses, will have access on the freeway during all stages of the works, with both the upper and lower arrester beds available.

Signage will be in place for motorists requiring access to the Mount Osmond Interchange, Mount Barker Road and Crafers Interchange.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe signage and speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

The Department appreciates your patience and cooperation while these important works are undertaken.



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
