



Grand Junction, Hampstead and Briens Road Intersection Upgrade

Night Works

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is upgrading the intersection of Grand Junction Road, Hampstead Road and Briens Road to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$19 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the South Australian and Australian governments.

While the majority of works are being undertaken during the day, some night works on Grand Junction Road and Briens Road in the vicinity of the intersection are required to minimise the impact to road users and to ensure the works can be completed safely and efficiently.

Works will commence from 7pm Tuesday, 1 June 2021, and are expected to be completed at the end of June 2021, weather permitting.

Hours of works are between 7pm and 6am Monday to Sunday. A respite night, where no works are undertaken, will be provided each week throughout these works.

The works will be undertaken in stages at various locations and include:

- Laying of new asphalt and the construction of new footpaths.
- Relocation of underground services.
- Installation of new LED road lighting.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise the disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

The intersection will remain open to traffic at all times, with speed and lane restrictions in place.

Please plan ahead and allow extra travel time, take extra care when workers are on site, and observe speed and lane restrictions and signage when travelling through the area.

Property access will be maintained throughout the works.

Public transport services will remain operational however, bus stops may require temporary relocation. Advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at the bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website www.adelaidemetro.com.au.

To ensure public safety, there will be temporary changes to pedestrian access at the north-west corner of the intersection in early June 2021, while the asphaltting work is completed at this location. Signage will be in place to advise pedestrians of alternative routes, with pedestrians directed to cross the road either west of the intersection on Grand Junction Road, or north-east of the intersection on Briens Road. This restriction will be in place until the end of July 2021.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area and observe detour signage.

Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

Further night works will be required during the upgrade, with advance notice of future night works will be provided as works progress.

The Department appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
