Information Act 1997

DIT has advised that it has undertaken an assessment of the road safety risks on the section of Main Road, between Black Road and Chandlers Hill Road. It has now commenced concept planning to cost and prioritise the work required to address the identified road safety risks. It is anticipated that this planning work will be completed by September 2021.

It should be noted that any potential works will need to be incorporated into a list with other candidate projects for prioritisation of funding on a state-wide basis. This is to ensure the funds available each year are allocated to the projects where the greatest benefit can be provided to the community as a whole."
