

Barrier Highway Upgrades

Safety barrier installation

We are delivering upgrades on the Barrier Highway between Cockburn and Burra to improve safety and accessibility for local residents and heavy vehicles. The \$62.5 million Barrier Highway upgrade program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening:

We are upgrading existing safety barriers on the Barrier Highway at various locations between Manna Hill and Olary to improve safety for all road users.

How this affects you:

To do this work safely, the Barrier Highway will be reduced to a single lane with temporary traffic signals in place to control the direction of traffic. Speed restrictions will be in place throughout the work area.

Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs. **Barrier Highway will remain open at all times** with speed restrictions still in place outside of work hours.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.
