

# Sturt Highway Corridor Upgrade

## Pavement Rehabilitation Works

We are upgrading the Sturt Highway, from Gawler to Renmark, to improve safety and traffic efficiency for road users. The upgrades are funded through the \$87.5 million Roads of Strategic Importance (ROSI) program, jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian Government (20%).

### What's happening:

Pavement rehabilitation will be undertaken on the Sturt Highway, between Bower Boundary Road, Steinfeld and Stonefield Road, Annadale.

### How this affects you:

To do this work safely, we will have speed and lane restrictions in work areas. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs. **The Sturt Highway will remain open at all times** with speed restrictions still in place outside of work hours.
