Night Works

What's happening:

Asphalt works will be undertaken along Russell Street, Main Road and Sheoak Road within the project area. The works will involve removing existing pavement and replacing it with new asphalt to ensure the long term safety and integrity of the roads for all road users.

How does this effect you

To keep you safe, **temporary detours will be in place at night**. Russell Street, Sheoak Road and Old Belair Road will be temporarily closed between the intersections of Main Road, Sheoak Road and Old Belair Road during night working hours. Please refer to the map overleaf for detour details.

Local access will be maintained under traffic controllers' assistance. Please plan ahead and expect some delays.

Main Road will remain open to traffic at all times with speed and lane restrictions in place while works are being undertaken.

Outside of night work hours all roads will be fully open to traffic with speed restrictions in place.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.
