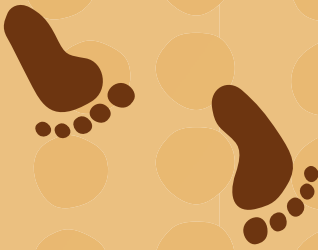

Aboriginal Secondary Students



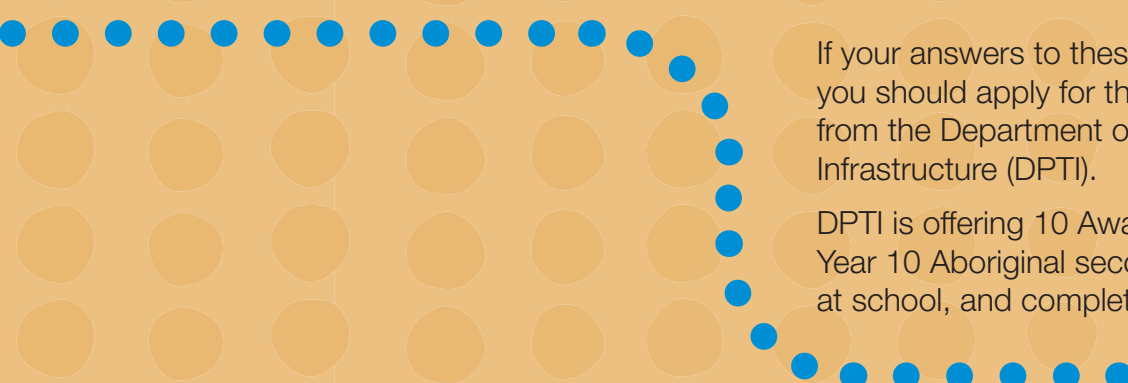
*Are you an Aboriginal student?*

*Would having your own laptop help you to stay at school and complete years 11 and 12?*

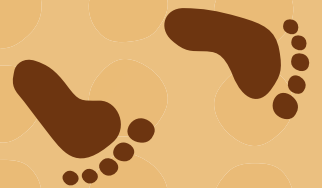


If your answers to these questions are **yes**, then you should apply for the Walpaara Anpa Award from the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI).

## Who is eligible to apply for an Award?

Aboriginal students currently completing year 10 and enrolled to complete SACE.

You have attended school regularly and achieved consistent results throughout the academic year.

## Walpaara Anpa Award Conditions

1. The student application form and the application support forms from your teacher and parent/guardian are completed and submitted by the due date.
2. A current copy of your school report card is attached to your application forms.
3. The laptop will be provided with software licensed to the successful applicant.
4. Your attendance at school must be consistent and your academic achievement must be satisfactory.
5. You are a positive role model to other Aboriginal students.

## Selection Panel

A selection panel will be established to assess the applications. This panel will be comprised of three Aboriginal people.
