

Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

Roundabout Upgrades, Mount Gambier

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users.

The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening:

We are upgrading the roundabout at the intersection of Wehl Street North and Jubilee Highway West.

How this affects you:

Works will commence from Monday 8 January 2024. From this time, traffic restrictions will be in place to keep everyone safe. Temporary traffic signals and/or traffic controllers will be on site to help manage the flow of traffic.

Northern access to and from Jubilee Highway and Wehl Street North will be closed from Monday 5 February 2024 for approximately two weeks, weather permitting. Please detour via Queens Avenue and Penola Road.

Southern access to and from Jubilee Highway and Wehl Street North will be closed from early March 2024. Advance notice will be provided.

When closures are in place, detours will be required at all times. All local motorists are encouraged to find alternative routes. Please see detour map overleaf. Onsite signage will be in place to provide advance notice of changes to detour requirements.

During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

Heavy Vehicles

To safely facilitate works at the Wehl Street North roundabout and other sites along Jubilee Highway West. The heavy vehicle detour via O'Leary Road, Pine Hall Avenue and Penola Road will be in place until April 2024, weather permitting. Please see map overleaf.


Following the completion of the Wehl Street North roundabout, advance notice will be provided of future works and associated detours for Heavy Vehicles.
