

Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

Roundabout upgrades, Mount Gambier

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users. The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening

Final pavement works are required at the Suttontown Road / Sutton Avenue roundabout to improve road quality and safety.

How this affects you

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. **Access to Suttontown Road and Sutton Avenue will be temporarily closed at the roundabout with a detour in place during work hours.** Works will occur on one side of the roundabout at a time. Please see overleaf for detour maps.

Access to **Sutton Road will be closed on Monday 19 and Thursday 22 February 2024.**

Access to **Suttontown Road will be closed on Tuesday 20 and Wednesday 21 February 2024.**

Short term speed and lane restrictions will also be required on **Friday 23 February 2024.**

One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Jubilee Highway West for eastbound and westbound traffic through the roundabout for the duration of the works. However, speed and lane restrictions will be required. Outside of work hours, access to and from the roundabout will be fully reinstated.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however we will minimise disturbance, as much as practically possible.

You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

Minor works including line marking will be required following the completion of these works under short-term speed and lane restrictions. Works at this location are expected to be fully completed by mid-March 2024.




Southern detour map

Access to Sutton Avenue will be closed on Monday 19 February and Thursday 22 February 2024. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction on Jubilee Highway West (Princes Highway).



Northern detour map

Access to Suttontown Road will be closed on Tuesday 20 February and Wednesday 21 February 2024. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction on Jubilee Highway West (Princes Highway).



Heavy vehicles

The detour for heavy vehicles will be required to recommence from Sunday 18 February 2024 until late June 2024. The detour will be via O’Leary Road, Pine Hall Avenue and Penola Road (Riddoch Highway).
