Barrier Highway remediation works update

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades on the Barrier Highway

These works are jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments as part of the \$168 million National Road Safety Program over 3 years.

What's happening

Major works on Barrier Highway, between Burra and Riverton, were completed in December 2024 with minor remediation works recently carried out between Manoora and Saddleworth.

The remaining 3km section south of Manoora will be completed after the winter season when conditions are suitable for this works to be carried out.

To keep everyone safe this section will be reduced to 80km/hr until all works are complete.

How this affects you

The Barrier Highway will remain open at all times.

Speed restrictions will remain in place south of Manoora. No works will be undertaken during the winter period, with works to complete the final 3km section completed by late 2025.

Advance notice will be provided prior to recommencement of works.

We thank you for your understanding while we complete these important safety upgrades.
