

Flinders Link Project

Vegetation management Birch Crescent, Tonsley

On behalf of the City of Marion, the Flinders Link Project will be undertaking removal of amenity trees and shrubs along the western side of Birch Crescent, adjacent the rail corridor, to facilitate the extension of the Tonsley Greenway, running between Alawoona Avenue and Sturt Road.

Works will be undertaken on Wednesday, 24 July, between 7:30am and 5pm.

To ensure the safety of pedestrians and road users while the works are undertaken a buffer zone will be implemented on the western side of Birch Crescent, adjacent the work area. Parking will be temporarily removed either side of Oak Avenue from 4pm on Tuesday 23 July until the completion of works at 5pm on Wednesday 24 July.

Traffic controllers will be on-site to assist motorists to safely access Birch Crescent. Access to properties will be maintained at all times, under the direction of traffic controllers.
