# New sign on trial

It has been brought to our attention that there is trial of speed limits on Fredrick Road, Seaton. The trial involves speed limits of 40km/hr between 8.00-9.00 am and 2.00-3:30 pm on school days from 150 metres north and south of the pedestrian crossing at Seaton High School. The trial commenced on 29 January 2018. No further sites will be fitted with these signs until the findings of the trial surveys are known.



Contravention of the speed limit within the time specified on the sign is a breach of the Australian Road Rules. Road Rules that relate include:

# 20 - Obeying the speed limit

21 - Speed limit where a speed limit sign applies

317 - Information on or with traffic control devices

318 - Limited effect of certain traffic control devices
