DPTI advised that the issue of concern from the previous meeting has been taken offline for discussion. A group member stated that DPTI/Gateway South handled the situation very well. A group member made an apology to the group following the meeting. Project Update

Project Update: Gateway South

- Service investigation works
- Potholing in Ragless Reserve is complete
- Tree removals are on-going

Project Update: DPTI

- Vegetation removal - out of 86 trees identified for removal, redesign had negated the removal of 10. With the scope extension an additional 32 trees have been identified for removal so far the Development Assessment Commission has approved the removal of 28 removed. DPTI showed the group which trees had been approved on the map.

Q: No mention of the trees in Ragless Reserve?

A: Not at this stage.

DPTI advised that there is a tree being removed on the corner of Franklin Avenue and Wentworth Avenue for Telstra works.

Q: When are the additional trees being removed?

4.	Round Table	<p>A group member advised that elected members receive monthly briefings.</p> <p>Q: What date will it be so DPTI can provide information?</p> <p>A: not sure at this stage.</p> <p>A group member raised that McDonalds is 2 hour parking only.</p> <p>A group member stated that motorists speed as they turn onto Sturt Road from Main South Road and only start slowing down to 40 km/h as they approach the police station.</p> <p>Q: Are there works occurring where the barriers are located in front of the police station?</p> <p>A: Yes.</p> <p>A group member raised the egress issue out of Bedford Park South.</p> <p>A group member advised that the parking consultation will be released tomorrow (26 August 2016) for a month. Once this has been completed the Bedford Park South egress issue will be addressed. As the egress issue out of Bedford Park South will take time, DPTI/Gateway South to still provide access from Main South Road into Bedford Park South.</p> <p>Discussion was had around selling of land off Riverside Drive.</p>	<p>DPTI to respond at the next meeting regarding selling of land off Riverside Drive.</p>

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Q: Will the noise wall be installed prior to the relocation of the road?

A: Gateway South advised that the intention is to build noise walls prior to construction of the temporary road.

A group member asked if DPTI will be picking up the cost of changing the easement on each owner's title and will the access points remain on the property side? DPTI to investigate.

Q: Will it affect the future plans for the intersection?

A: Development Assessment Commission will assess this as part of their investigation.

Discussion was had around the Flinders Link and the new Flinders station. It was discussed if the station will be enclosed and if there will be shops/apartments in the vicinity.

Q: Can you turn left heading north onto the Southern Expressway from Main South Road?

A: No.

Discussion was had around the lighting along Main South Road which has improved.

Discussion was had around motorist's turning into Bedford Park South from Main South Road. DPTI advised that they would meet onsite with a group member to discuss the concerns.

DPTI to follow up on changes to easements on owners titles and where the access point will be.

DPTI to meet with group members on site to discuss concerns with access into Bedford Park South.
