Darlington Upgrade Project

Night Works

Monday 23 October – Thursday 26 October 2017

Junction of South Road and Tonsley Boulevard, St Marys

As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project, night works will be undertaken at the junction of South Road and Tonsley Boulevard from Monday 23 October until Thursday 26 October 2017.

The works will occur between the hours of 7pm and 6am and will involve testing of recently installed piles for the new Tonsley Boulevard bridge.

A crane, hammer testing equipment, trucks and lighting towers will be used. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed.

Traffic Management

- All traffic movements at the Tonsley Boulevard junction with South Road will be maintained during the works.
- Access along South Road will remain available at all times.
- Signage will alert motorists to the changed traffic conditions and traffic controllers will be onsite to direct motorists as required.
- Lane and speed restrictions will apply on Tonsley Boulevard and South Road in the vicinity of the works.

Works will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents as much as possible. However, some noise can be expected.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed and lane restrictions when travelling through the area.
