

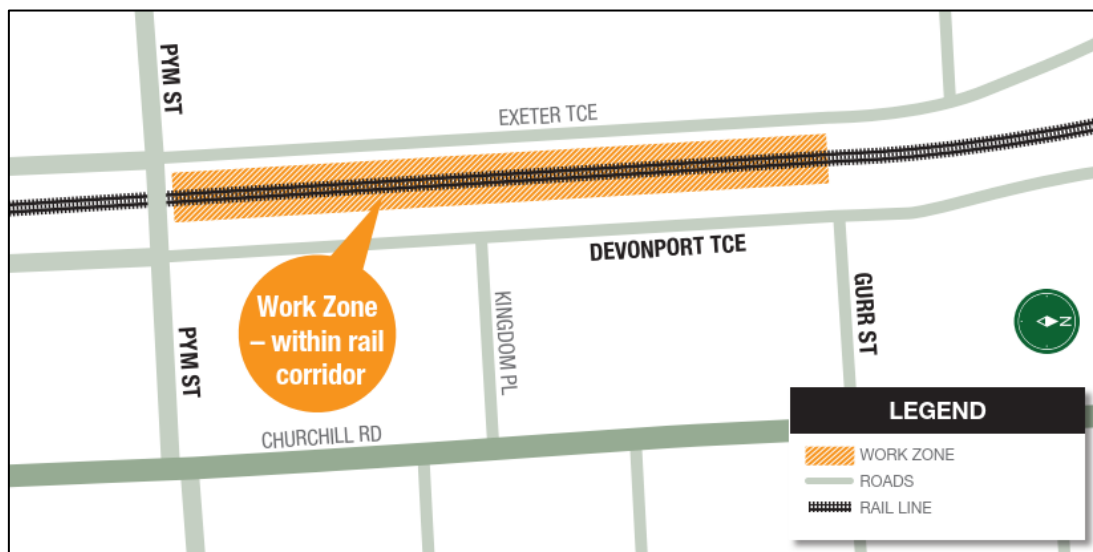
# Gawler Rail Electrification Project

## Works Notification

As part of the Gawler Rail Electrification Project, the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) advises that works will be undertaken within the rail corridor between Pym Street and Gurr Street, Prospect.

**Location:** Within the rail corridor between Pym Street and Gurr Street, Prospect (refer to map).

**When:** From 21 October for approximately 3 weeks, weather permitting. Standard work hours will be Monday to Saturday between 7am and 7pm.



### What is happening:

- Works involve trenching within the rail corridor to install underground services to support a new signalling system.
- No vegetation will be removed as part of this works program.
- There will be no changes to passenger services for this works program.
- Local traffic management will be required with some speed restrictions to control work vehicles' access to the rail corridor.
- There will be temporary stockpiles of sand and soil within the rail corridor while works are undertaken. These will be removed at the conclusion of this work program.
- There will be further works required in this area to install masts, overhead wiring and fencing. The Project Team will provide more information about these works prior to them being undertaken. Work crews will make every effort to minimise any disturbance to residents and businesses.
