

Darlington Upgrade Project

17-20 January 2020 – change traffic arrangements

As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project, changed traffic arrangements will be in place over the weekend of 17-20 January for works to open access ramps connecting the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway) to the Tonsley Boulevard intersection. Gantry installation and road resurfacing works will also be undertaken.

These works are being undertaken in conjunction with the girder installation for the Flinders Link Project and will include both day and night works. Details on road access during the works, and the traffic switch arrangements are provided below and in the map overleaf.

During these works, the northbound bridge over the Southern Expressway to the Main South Road surface road will remain closed, with access to Sturt Road and Laffer Drive via Marion Road.

Flinders Drive access via Main South Road will remain unchanged. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times during these works.

Southern Expressway from 6am-6pm Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 January, traffic arrangements

- For southbound traffic the Southern Expressway, including the lowered motorway, will be closed between Sherriffs Road, Lonsdale and Tonsley Boulevard, St Marys.
- For northbound traffic, the Southern Expressway will be closed, however northbound motorists will be permitted to use Main South Road for access to South Road and Ayliffes Road via the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway).

Ayliffes Road intersection from 6pm Saturday 18 – 6am Monday 20 January, traffic arrangements

Restrictions at the Shepherds Hill Road, Ayliffes Road and South Road intersection will be in place for resurfacing and utility service works as listed below.

- Access to Shepherds Hill Road from South Road will not be available. Motorists will be required to detour via Main South Road and Sturt Road.
- Access to South Road and Ayliffes Road from Shepherds Hill Road will not be available. Motorists will be required to detour via Sturt Road and Main South Road.
- Access to the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway) will not be available from South Road or Ayliffes Road, St Marys. Motorists will need to use the Main South Road on-ramp adjacent Flinders Drive.
- Ayliffes Road will be reduced to a single lane southbound.
- Bus routes 300 and G10 will detour via Sturt Road and Main South Road.
- Bus stops 25 and 26 (western side) on Shepherds Hill Road and bus stop 26 on Sturt Road (both directions) will be temporarily closed. For further information regarding detours, changes to bus stops and timetables please visit www.adelaidemetro.com.au
- Pedestrian access along Ayliffes Road, Shepherds Hill Road and South Road will be retained.
- Please see the map overleaf for further details.

Traffic signals at the Shepherds Hill Road, Ayliffes Road and South Road intersection will not be operational during the works – they will flash amber.

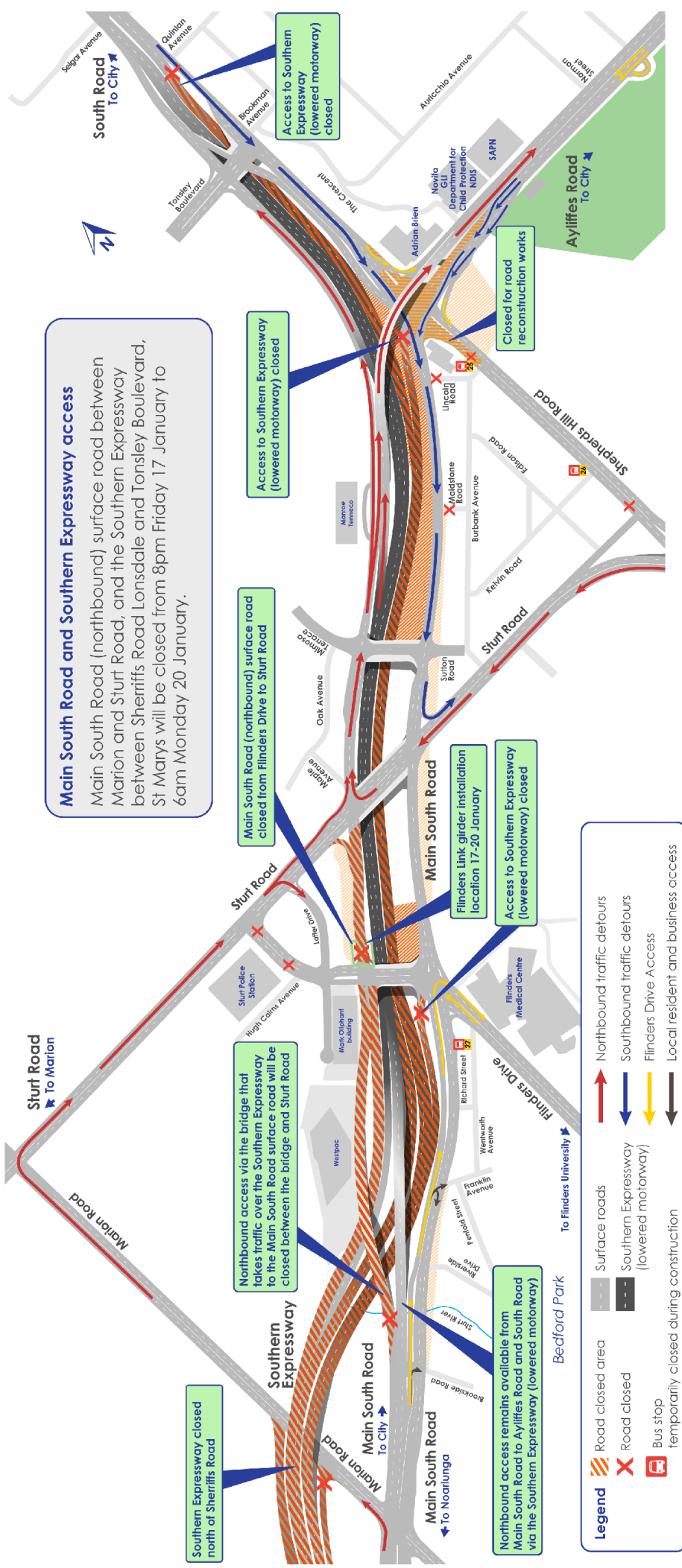
A profiler, crane, excavator, asphalt truck and lighting towers will be used. There will be some noise while these works are completed, however the works will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents as much as possible.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. These works are weather dependant and may need to be rescheduled.

Southern Expressway and Ayliffes Road intersection

Changed traffic conditions

6pm Friday 17 - 6am Monday 20 January



Main South Road and Southern Expressway access
Main South Road (northbound) surface road between Marion and Sturt Road, and the Southern Expressway between Sheriffs Road Lonsdale and Tonsley Boulevard, St Marys will be closed from 8pm Friday 17 January to 6am Monday 20 January.

Northbound access via the bridge that takes traffic over the Southern Expressway to the Main South Road surface road will be closed between the bridge and Sturt Road

Access to Southern Expressway (lowered motorway) closed

Main South Road (northbound) surface road closed from Flinders Drive to Sturt Road

Northern Expressway closed north of Sheriffs Road

Flinders Link girder installation location 17-20 January

Northbound access remains available from Main South Road to Ayliffes Road and South Road via the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway)

Closed for road reconstruction works

Traffic switch from 6am Monday 20 January

Access to the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway) for southbound traffic will be available before the Tonsley Boulevard intersection, north of Quinlan Avenue. As a result, both northbound and southbound traffic will be able to travel non-stop along the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway) between South Road at Tonsley and the existing Southern Expressway.

Access from the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway) onto the South Road surface road near Tonsley Boulevard for northbound traffic will be available.

Northbound traffic on the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway) from north of the Ayliffes Road bridge access ramp will be shifted to the west to its final alignment.

Southbound traffic on South Road wanting to travel to Sturt Road, Flinders Drive and Darlington will need to position themselves in the left hand lane prior to the Tonsley on-ramp and remain on the surface road.

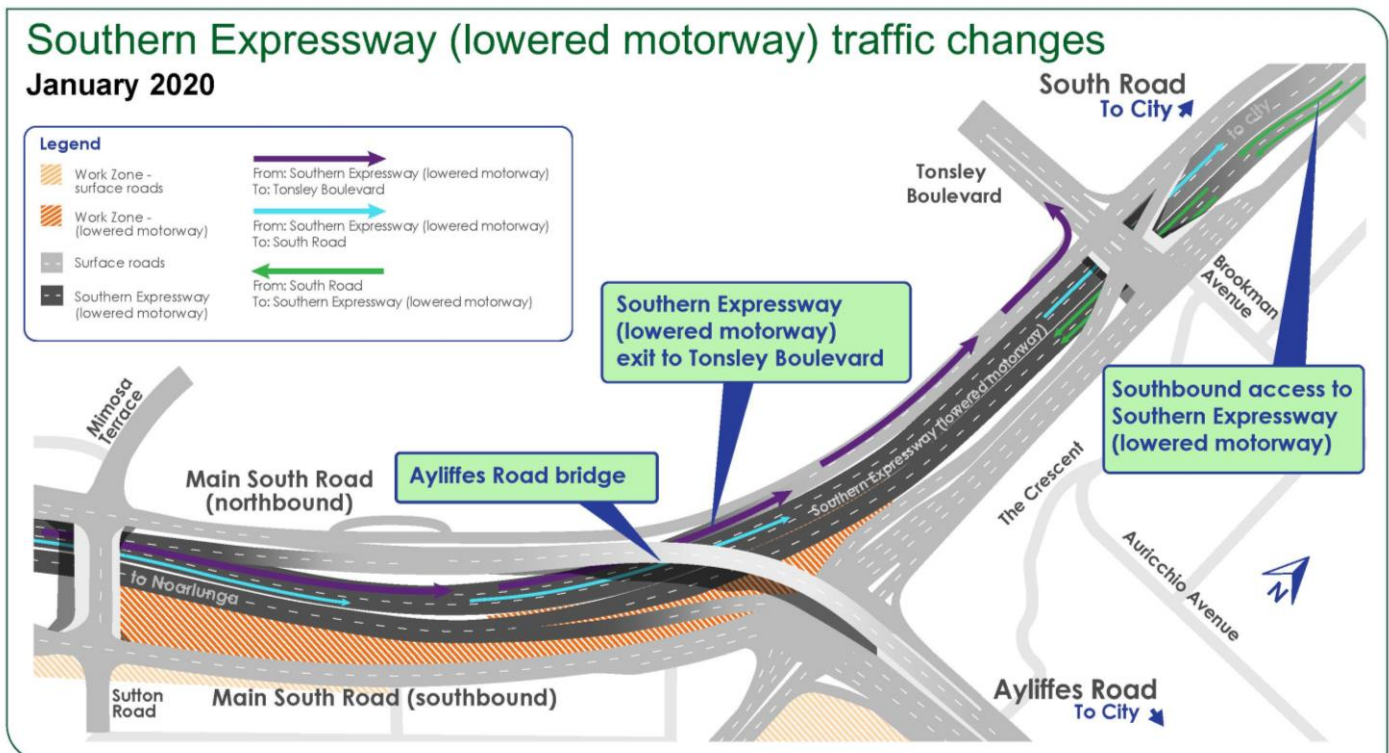
See the below for details of the traffic arrangements that will be in place following the switch. Motorists are advised to follow signage on site and take extra care while driving in the changed conditions.

From: South Road, southbound To: Southern Expressway (lowered motorway)

Southbound South Road traffic wanting to travel to the Southern Expressway will be able to travel into the new Southern Expressway (lowered motorway) (see green arrows on the plan below).

From: Southern Expressway (lowered motorway), northbound To: South Road

Northbound Southern Expressway traffic wanting to travel to Tonsley Boulevard will be able to position themselves in the left lane of the Southern Expressway (lowered motorway), north of the Ayliffes Road bridge to exit to South Road and access Tonsley Boulevard (see the purple arrows on the plan below).
